

# **SENATE BILL No. 417**

March 21, 1995, Introduced by Senators STEIL, HOFFMAN, VAN REGENMORTER, CARL, SHUGARS, GAST, DEGROW, ROGERS, STILLE, EMMONS, MCMANUS, NORTH and DUNASKISS and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend the title and sections 1, 2, 4, 19, 20, 30,

and 37 of Act No. 44 of the Public Acts of 1899, entitled as

amended

"An act to provide for the publication and distribution of laws and documents, reports of the several officers, boards of officers and public institutions of this state now or hereafter to be published; to provide for the replacing of books lost by fire or otherwise; to provide for the publication and distribution of the Michigan manual; and to establish certain funds,"

sections 1, 2, and 37 as amended by Act No. 97 of the Public Acts of 1983 and section 30 as amended by Act No. 185 of the Public Acts of 1988, being sections 24.1, 24.2, 24.4, 24.19, 24.20, 24.30, and 24.37 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

### THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. The title and sections 1, 2, 4, 19, 20, 30, and
 37 of Act No. 44 of the Public Acts of 1899, sections 1, 2, and
 3 37 as amended by Act No. 97 of the Public Acts of 1983 and

1 section 30 as amended by Act No. 185 of the Public Acts of 1988, 2 being sections 24.1, 24.2, 24.4, 24.19, 24.20, 24.30, and 24.37 3 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:

#### TITLE

5 An act to provide for the publication and distribution of 6 PUBLICATIONS, laws, and documents, reports of the several offi-7 cers, boards of officers and public institutions of this state 8 now or hereafter to be published; to provide for the replacing of 9 -books PUBLICATIONS lost by fire or otherwise; to provide for 10 the publication and distribution of the Michigan manual; -and TO 11 PROVIDE FOR DUTIES OF CERTAIN STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT DEPART-12 MENTS AND AGENCIES; to establish certain funds; AND TO PROVIDE 13 FOR CERTAIN PENALTIES AND REMEDIES.

Sec. 1. (1) The legislative service bureau, under the direction of the legislative council, shall, as soon as practicable after the close of any session of the legislature, carefully rexamine, classify, assign compilation numbers to, catchline, and nex the acts passed and prepare them for publication by the legislative service bureau. <u>in a single bound volume which</u> THE PUBLICATION shall include the following:

21 (a) A title, page, preface, and table of contents.

(b) All acts of a general character which affect the people23 of the whole state.

24 (c) All joint resolutions.

(d) All amendments to the state constitution of 1963 adopted
26 after the publication of the acts of the last preceding session
27 of the legislature.

(e) All acts of a local or municipal character which do not
 2 affect the people of the whole state.

3 (f) All initiated laws.

4 (g) All veto messages of the governor.

5 (h) All executive orders by which the governor makes changes 6 in the organization of the executive branch or in the assignment 7 of functions among its units which require the force of law.

8 (i) Abstracts of proceedings of boards of supervisors orga-9 nizing new townships, consolidating townships, or changing the 10 boundaries of townships, received and filed in the office of the 11 secretary of state after the publication of the acts of the pre-12 vious session of the legislature.

(j) Abstracts of proceedings relative to incorporation and A change of boundaries of cities and villages filed in the office of the secretary of state after the publication of the acts of the previous session of the legislature.

17 (k) Abstracts of proceedings relative to the incorporation 18 of charter townships filed in the office of the secretary of 19 state after the publication of the acts of the previous session 20 of the legislature.

(1) A certificate of the secretary of state setting forth
the date of the final adjournment of the legislative session at
which the acts published were enacted, and setting forth in the
same certificate the date upon which all such acts, not given
immediate effect or carrying an effective date, shall take effect
according to the state constitution of 1963.

(m) That part of the annual report of the state treasurer
 for the latest completed fiscal year as shall give an accurate
 account of the receipts and expenditures of public money.

4 (n) The Michigan compiled laws table.

5 (o) An index.

6 (2) The legislative service bureau, under the direction of 7 the legislative council, shall include each final ADOPTED appor-8 tionment and districting plan <u>adopted in the single bound volume</u> 9 <del>of</del> WITH the public and local acts of the first regular session 10 following the date on which the plan becomes law.

11 (3) The items described in subsections (1) and (2) shall be 12 published <u>in t-volume</u>, with the following TITLE text: <u>embossed</u> 13 on the spine of the volume in high quality imitation gold stamp 14 ing foil:

19 (4) The public and local acts shall be sequentially arranged 20 by act number, with <u>boldface</u> BOLDFACED compilation numbers and 21 catchlines of a style similar to compilation numbers and catch-22 lines in the Michigan Compiled Laws. The senate or house of rep-23 resentatives bill number of each public or local act <u>appearing</u> 24 in the volume shall appear in parentheses in <u>boldface</u>.

1 BOLDFACED type immediately below the act number. In cases where 2 a section appearing in the last preceding compilation of the gen-3 eral laws has been amended, the catchline of that section shall 4 contain the compilation number given to that section in the com-5 pilation and that number shall be <u>printed</u> in <u>boldface</u>. 6 BOLDFACED type. The corresponding citation to the Michigan stat-7 utes annotated shall be placed in brackets in boldface immedi-8 ately following and as part of the catchline to each section. 9 <u>The style of printing, size, style and arrangement of type, and</u> 10 the size of the page for the volumes shall be similar to that of 11 the last preceding compilation of the general laws. Cardinal 12 numerals shall be printed in figures and not written out, except 13 when a sentence begins with a cardinal numeral.

14 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "PUBLICATION" OR "PUBLISHED"
15 MEANS THE PRODUCTION AND DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION IN PRINT,
16 MICROFILM, MICROFICHE, OR ELECTRONIC FORM.

17 Sec. 2. (1) Upon written request to the legislative serv18 ice bureau, the department of management and budget shall dis19 tribute, without charge, 1 volume containing the public and local
20 acts of each session of the legislature to each of the

21 following:

22 (a) Libraries of all state officers, departments, boards,
 23 commissions, and institutions.

24 (b) Senators and representatives of this state in congress.

25 (c) The library of congress.

26 (d) The United States supreme court and judges and clerks of
 27 circuit and district courts of the United States in this state.

(e) Justices, clerks, and the reporter of the state supreme
 court.

3 (f) Judges of the court of appeals, circuit, recorder's,
4 district, and municipal courts of this state.

5 (g) All public libraries, as defined in section 1 of Act
6 No. 59 of the Public Acts of 1964, being section 397.31 of the
7 Michigan Compiled Laws, and all county law libraries.

(2) -(3) The county clerk shall file a requisition for all copies of the public and local acts for the needs of the clerk's county, including county officers and townships, villages, and cities and their officers within the clerk's county, with the legislative service bureau by February 15, of each year. There may be published additional copies of the public and local acts 27 as the legislative service bureau considers necessary. One

1 hundred forty of those copies shall be deposited in the state 2 library for use in the library and for exchanges, and the 3 remaining UNLESS OTHERWISE DIRECTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICE 4 BUREAU, THESE copies shall be deposited with the department of 5 management and budget for sale and future distribution.

6 (3) -(4)- The legislative service bureau may prepare, at not 7 less than the actual cost, reprints of laws upon particular 8 subjects for printing and distribution. The department of trea-9 sury shall publish and distribute all pamphlets of the general 10 tax law or of all other laws relating to the revenues of the 11 state.

(4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "PUBLICATION" OR "PUBLISHED"
13 MEANS THE PRODUCTION AND DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION IN PRINT,
14 MICROFILM, MICROFICHE, OR ELECTRONIC FORM.

Sec. 4. All the <u>volumes</u> COPIES of the state laws, legisle lative manuals, and other <u>books</u> PUBLICATIONS, hereafter publ7 lished and distributed, and required to be retained in any l8 library, or passed over by any officer to his OR HER successor in l9 office, shall have marked <u>or branded on both covers thereof</u> the 20 words "State property."

Sec. 19. (1) All reports enumerated in this act which are made annually shall be <u>printed</u> PUBLISHED annually. <del>; and all</del> (2) ALL reports enumerated in this act which are made bien-24 nially shall be <u>printed</u> PUBLISHED biennially.

25 Sec. 20. There shall be printed COPIES of all publica-26 tions, reports, and documents as provided in this act -, such 27 additional copies MAY BE PROVIDED for use and exchanges by the

1 state library as the state librarian may <u>in-his-discretion-deem</u> 2 CONSIDER necessary for such purpose.

3 Sec. 30. (1) The legislative service bureau shall publish 4 sufficient copies of the "Michigan Manual", to be distributed as 5 provided in -subsections SUBSECTION (2) -and (3) - and as 6 directed by the legislative council.

7 (2) The department of management and budget shall deliver 1 8 copy of the manual-to each of the following: senators and repre 9 sentatives in congress from this state; United States circuit and 10 district court judges in this state; justices of the state 11 supreme court; judges of the court of appeals; and the judges of 12 the circuit, district, and probate courts; each district, graded 13 and city public school, and parochial school; each high school, 14 public, private, and parochial, in this state; each public 15 library other than school libraries; and archives that are in, or 16 a part of, public institutions in this state.

17 (2) -(3)- The department of management and budget shall
18 -also deliver the following number of copies to THE FOLLOWING
19 PERSONS: the governor, 5; lieutenant governor, 5; secretary of
20 state, 5; state treasurer, 5; auditor general, 5; attorney gener21 al, 5; superintendent of public instruction, 5; Michigan public
22 service commission, 1; state tax commission, 1; department of
23 natural resources, 1; financial institutions bureau, department
24 of commerce, 1; department of agriculture, 1; insurance bureau,
25 department of commerce, 1; department of labor, 1; corporation
26 and securities bureau, department of commerce, 1; members-

(A) MEMBERS of the senate, 1. -25; speaker of the house, -25;
 2 members -

3 (B) MEMBERS of the house, 1. except speaker, 25; secretary 4 of the senate, 10; clerk of the house, 10; the adjutant general, 5 <del>1.</del>

6 (3) -(4) The legislative service bureau shall determine a 7 price per -volume PUBLICATION COPY not to exceed the cost of 8 preparation -, printing, and distribution -, and, UNLESS 9 DIRECTED OTHERWISE BY THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICE BUREAU, the depart-10 ment of management and budget shall sell the -volumes- COPIES OF 11 THE PUBLICATION not distributed pursuant to -subsections 12 SUBSECTION (2). -and (3).

13 (4) -(5) The Michigan manual fund is created in the state 14 treasury and shall be administered by the legislative council. 15 Any money received from the sale of the Michigan manual shall be 16 deposited with the state treasurer to the credit of the Michigan 17 manual fund and shall be used to pay the costs of preparing -718 printing, and distributing the Michigan manual.

(5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "PUBLICATION" OR "PUBLISHED"
20 MEANS THE PRODUCTION AND DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION IN PRINT,
21 MICROFILM, MICROFICHE, OR ELECTRONIC FORM.

22 Sec. 37. (1) A sufficient number of <u>sets</u> PUBLICATIONS of 23 the Michigan compiled laws shall be <u>delivered</u> PROVIDED to the 24 department of management and budget for distribution as follows:

25 -(a)-One-set-to-the-library-of-congress.

26 (b) One set to the governor.

(c) One set to the lieutenant governor.

2 (A) (d) One set PUBLICATION COPY to each member of the 3 legislature.

4 (B) -(e)- Forty -sets- PUBLICATION COPIES to the secretary 5 of the state senate for use as desk copies by the members of the 6 senate.

7 (C) -(f) One hundred fourteen -sets - PUBLICATION COPIES to
8 the clerk of the state house of representatives for use as desk
9 copies by the members of the house of representatives.

10 -(g) One set to the secretary of the state senate.

11 (h) One set to the clerk of the state house of

12 representatives.

13 (2) Additional set of the Michigan compiled laws, in the 14 quantities specified in this subsection, shall be distributed by 15 the department of management and budget, upon written request to 16 the legislative service bureau from 1 or more of the following 17 entities:

18 (a) One set to each justice of the state supreme court.

19 (b) One set to the clerk of the state supreme court.

20 (c) One-set to the reporter of the state supreme court.

21 (d) Four sets to the court administrator's office.

22 (e) One set to each judge of every court of this state.

23 (f) One-set to each prosecuting attorney.

24 (g) One set to each county law library.

25 (h) One set to the county board of commissioners of each 26 county, which set shall be located in the county courthouse and

27 available to the public.

(i) One set to each state supported university or college.
 (j) One set to each private university or college of this
 3 state which is accredited by the north central association of
 4 colleges and secondary schools.

5 (k) Two hundred fifty sets to the state library for use in
6 the library and for exchanges.

7 (*t*) A number of sets as determined by the legislative serv8 ice bureau for use in the executive office of the governor, each
9 state department, the legislative council and offices, councils,
10 bureaus, and committees of the legislature.

(3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "PUBLICATION" OR "PUBLISHED"
