

## **SENATE BILL No. 454**

April 19, 1995, Introduced by Senator SHUGARS and referred to the Committee on Local, Urban and State Affairs.

A bill to amend the title and sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, and 15 of Act No. 440 of the Public Acts of 1988, entitled

"Asbestos workers accreditation act,"

being sections 338.3402, 338.3403, 338.3404, 338.3405, 338.3406, 338.3407, 338.3409, 338.3410, 338.3411, 338.3412, 338.3413, 338.3414, and 338.3415 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. The title and sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10,
- 2 11, 12, 13, 14, and 15 of Act No. 440 of the Public Acts of 1988,
- 3 being sections 338.3402, 338.3403, 338.3404, 338.3405, 338.3406,
- 4 338.3407, 338.3409, 338.3410, 338.3411, 338.3412, 338.3413,

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- 1 338.3414, and 338.3415 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended 2 to read as follows:
- 3 TITLE
- An act to provide for the accreditation of persons who per-
- 5 form asbestos-related work in schools, -and- school buildings,
- 6 AND PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS; to prescribe the powers and
- 7 duties of certain state agencies and officers; to prescribe reme-
- 8 dies and penalties; and to assess certain fees.
- 9 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 10 (A) "ACBM" MEANS ASBESTOS-CONTAINING BUILDING MATERIAL.
- (B) -(a) "Asbestos" means a group of naturally occurring
- 12 minerals that separate into fibers, including chrysotile, amo-
- 13 site, crocidolite, anthophyllite asbestos, tremolite asbestos,
- 14 and actinolite asbestos.
- 15 (C) "ASBESTOS MODEL ACCREDITATION PLAN" MEANS THE ASBESTOS
- 16 MODEL ACCREDITATION PLAN ISSUED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION
- 17 AGENCY, APPENDIX C TO SUBPART E OF PART 763 OF TITLE 40 OF THE
- 18 CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS.
- (D) -(b)- "Asbestos-related work" means any activity or task
- 20 performed by a person working with asbestos in buildings, includ-
- 21 ing, but not limited to, inspection, management plan development,
- 22 the design or conduct of response actions, and remedial work.
- 23 (E) -(c)- "Certificate of accreditation" means a numbered
- 24 document issued by the director pursuant to AS PROVIDED IN sec-
- 25 tion 13 to a person who possesses the necessary qualifications
- 26 and who successfully completes the initial training and
- 27 examination required by this act.

- (F) (d) "Day of training" means the equivalent of 8 hours, 2 including breaks and lunch which shall THAT DO not exceed 1 3 hour.
- 4 (G) <del>(e)-</del> "Department" means the department of public 5 health.
- 6 (H) -(f) "Director" means the director of public health or 7 his or her authorized representative.
- 8 (I) "INSPECTION" MEANS AN ACTIVITY UNDERTAKEN IN A SCHOOL
- 9 BUILDING OR PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING TO DETERMINE THE PRES-
- 10 ENCE OR LOCATION OR TO ASSESS THE CONDITION OF FRIABLE OR NONFRI-
- 11 ABLE ACBM OR SUSPECTED ACBM, WHETHER BY VISUAL OR PHYSICAL EXAMI-
- 12 NATION, OR BY COLLECTING SAMPLES OF MATERIAL. INSPECTION
- 13 INCLUDES REINSPECTIONS OF KNOWN OR ASSUMED ACBM THAT HAS BEEN
- 14 PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED. INSPECTION DOES NOT INCLUDE THE
- 15 FOLLOWING:
- 16 (i) PERIODIC SURVEILLANCE OF THE TYPE DESCRIBED IN 40
- 17 C.F.R. 763.92(b) SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECORDING OR REPORTING
- 18 A CHANGE IN THE CONDITION OF KNOWN OR ASSUMED ACBM.
- 19 (ii) INSPECTIONS PERFORMED BY EMPLOYEES OR AGENTS OF FEDER-
- 20 AL, STATE, OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETER-
- 21 MINING COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE STATUTES OR REGULATIONS.
- 22 (iii) VISUAL INSPECTIONS OF THE TYPE DESCRIBED IN 40
- 23 C.F.R. 763.90(i) SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING COMPLETION
- 24 OF RESPONSE ACTIONS.
- 25 (iv) LIMITED SCOPE INSPECTIONS ASSOCIATED WITH A REMODELING,
- 26 RENOVATION, OPERATION, OR MAINTENANCE ACTIVITY IN A PUBLIC AND
- 27 COMMERCIAL BUILDING THAT INVOLVES NOT MORE THAN 2 HOMOGENEOUS

- 1 AREAS AS DEFINED IN 40 C.F.R. 763.83 AND NOT MORE THAN 6 BULK
- 2 SAMPLES COLLECTED IN A RANDOMLY DISTRIBUTED MANNER.
- 3 (J) "INTERIOR SPACE" MEANS AN ENCLOSED PORTION OF A PUBLIC
- 4 AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING, INCLUDING AN EXTERIOR HALLWAY, CONNECT-
- 5 ING STRUCTURE, PORTICO, OR MECHANICAL SYSTEM USED TO CONDITION AN
- 6 ENCLOSED SPACE.
- 7 (K)  $\frac{(g)}{}$  "Person" means an individual, partnership, associ-
- 8 ation, corporation, public or private agency, or other legal
- 9 entity. PERSON DOES NOT INCLUDE A HOMEOWNER PERFORMING
- 10 ASBESTOS-RELATED WORK WITHIN HIS OR HER OWN HOME.
- 1) (1) "PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING" MEANS THE INTERIOR
- 12 SPACE OF A BUILDING THAT IS NOT A SCHOOL BUILDING, A RESIDENTIAL
- 13 APARTMENT BUILDING OF FEWER THAN 10 UNITS, OR A DETACHED SINGLE
- 14 FAMILY HOME. PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT
- 15 LIMITED TO, ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 16 (i) INDUSTRIAL AND OFFICE BUILDINGS.
- 17 (ii) RESIDENTIAL APARTMENT BUILDINGS AND CONDOMINIUMS OF 10
- 18 OR MORE DWELLING UNITS.
- 19 (iii) GOVERNMENT OWNED BUILDINGS.
- 20 (iv) COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES.
- 21 (v) MUSEUMS.
- (vi) AIRPORTS.
- vii) HOSPITALS.
- 24 (viii) CHURCHES.
- (ix) PRESCHOOLS.
- 26 (x) STORES.

- (xi) WAREHOUSES.
- 2 (xii) FACTORIES.
- 3 (M) -(h) "School" means a private or public elementary or
- 4 secondary institution of learning including grades kindergarten
- 5 through grade 12.
- 6 (N) -(i) "School building" means any of the following at a 7 school:
- 8 (i) A structure suitable for use as a classroom, including a
- 9 school laboratory, library, eating facility, or food preparation
- 10 facility.
- (ii) A gymnasium or other facility —which— THAT is specially
- 12 designed for athletic or recreational activities or for an aca-
- 13 demic course in physical education.
- (iii) A facility used for the instruction or housing of stu-
- 15 dents for the purpose of administration of educational or
- 16 research programs.
- (iv) A maintenance, storage, or utility facility, including

- 24 working time was spent on asbestos-related work, or an equivalent
- 25 amount of work over more than 1 year's time if it was conducted
- 26 after January 1, 1983.

- 1 Sec. 3. A person shall not perform -any of the following
- 2 asbestos-related work in A school -buildings BUILDING OR A
- 3 PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING in this state unless that person
- 4 receives a certificate of accreditation and maintains annual
- 5 reaccreditation through training, examination, and continuing
- 6 education -pursuant to UNDER this act:
- 7 (a) Inspect for asbestos-containing materials in A school
- 8 buildings under the authority of a school building's owner,
- 9 operator, or agent BUILDING OR A PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING,
- 10 UNLESS THE INDIVIDUAL PERFORMING THE INSPECTION IS CERTIFIED BY
- 11 THE AMERICAN BOARD OF INDUSTRIAL HYGIENE AS A CERTIFIED INDUS-
- 12 TRIAL HYGIENIST.
- (b) Prepare AN asbestos management —plans—PLAN for A school
- 14 buildings BUILDING.
- (c) Design -or conduct response actions A RESPONSE ACTION
- 16 beyond the scope of A small-scale, -or short-duration operations
- 17 maintenance and repair -activities ACTIVITY, OR A RESPONSE
- 18 ACTION TO A MAJOR FIBER RELEASE EPISODE, as those terms are
- 19 defined in work practices and engineering controls for A
- 20 small-scale, short-duration operations maintenance and repair
- 21 (O&M) activities involving ACM, 52 F.R. appendix B to subpart E,
- 22 p. 41894 (October 30, 1987) ACTIVITY IN THE ASBESTOS MODEL
- 23 ACCREDITATION PLAN.
- 24 (D) CONDUCT A RESPONSE ACTION BEYOND THE SCOPE OF
- 25 SMALL-SCALE, SHORT-DURATION OPERATIONS MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR
- 26 ACTIVITY OR AN ACTIVITY THAT INVOLVES A MAJOR FIBER RELEASE
- 27 EPISODE, AS THOSE TERMS AS DEFINED IN THE ASBESTOS MODEL

- 1 ACCREDITATION PLAN. HOWEVER, THIS SUBDIVISION DOES NOT APPLY TO
- 2 CLASS II ASBESTOS WORK INVOLVING ONLY THE REMOVAL OR DISTURBANCE
- 3 OF 1 GENERIC CATEGORY OF BUILDING MATERIAL, CLASS III ASBESTOS
- 4 WORK, OR CLASS IV ASBESTOS WORK THAT IS NOT PERFORMED IN A REGU-
- 5 LATED AREA, AS THOSE TERMS ARE DEFINED IN THE OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY
- 6 AND HEALTH ADMINISTRATION'S STANDARDS FOR OCCUPATIONAL EXPOSURE
- 7 TO ASBESTOS IN THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY, 59 F.R. 1926. 1101,
- 8 P. 41132 (AUGUST 10, 1994).
- 9 Sec. 4. (1) A person who seeks accreditation to perform
- 10 asbestos-related work in A school buildings BUILDING OR A
- 11 PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING in this state shall be IS
- 12 required to complete initial training -pursuant to UNDER this
- 13 act. This initial training shall provide training EDUCATION in
- 14 asbestos-containing materials inspection, management plan devel-
- 15 opment, and response action technology.
- 16 (2) The length of THE initial training -courses COURSE
- 17 required for accreditation -pursuant to UNDER this act shall
- 18 vary by discipline as follows:
- (a) Asbestos inspectors shall be required to AN ASBESTOS
- 20 INSPECTOR SHALL complete a 3-day training course and successfully
- 21 pass an examination.
- 22 (b) Asbestos management planners shall be required to AN
- 23 ASBESTOS MANAGEMENT PLANNER SHALL complete the inspector training
- 24 course as prescribed by subdivision (a) plus an additional 2 days
- 25 of training devoted to management planning and shall successfully
- 26 pass an examination on each course of training.

- 1 (c) Asbestos abatement project designers shall be required
- 2 to have at least AN ASBESTOS ABATEMENT PROJECT DESIGNER SHALL
- 3 COMPLETE NOT LESS THAN 3 days of training and successfully pass
- 4 an examination. , or shall successfully complete the 4 day
- 5 training course and pass the examination prescribed by subdivi-
- 6 sion (d).
- 7 (d) Asbestos abatement contractors and supervisors shall be
- 8 required to AN ASBESTOS ABATEMENT CONTRACTOR OR SUPERVISOR SHALL
- 9 complete a -4 day 5-DAY training course and successfully pass an
- 10 examination.
- (e) Asbestos abatement workers shall be required to AN
- 12 ASBESTOS ABATEMENT WORKER SHALL complete a -3 day 4-DAY training
- 13 course and successfully pass an examination.
- 14 (3) A person who seeks reaccreditation -pursuant to UNDER
- 15 this act to perform asbestos-related work in A school buildings
- 16 BUILDING OR A PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING in this state shall
- 17 be required to complete a 1-day annual refresher training
- 18 course, except that AN asbestos inspectors shall only be
- 19 INSPECTOR IS ONLY required to complete a 1/2-day ANNUAL refresher
- 20 training course.
- Sec. 5. (1) A person who meets the requirements of this act
- 22 and who completes the initial training and passes the examination
- 23 required pursuant to section 4(1) and (2) UNDER SECTION 4 shall
- 24 receive a certificate of accreditation from the director
- 25 -pursuant to IN ACCORDANCE WITH section 13. The certificate of
- 26 accreditation shall authorize the person to perform
- 27 asbestos-related work in A school -buildings BUILDING OR A

- 1 PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING in this state for a period of 1
- 2 year after its issuance.
- 3 (2) A person who completes the refresher training course
- 4 required pursuant to section 4(3) UNDER SECTION 4 shall receive
- 5 an annual certificate of reaccreditation from the director
- 6 -pursuant to IN ACCORDANCE WITH section 13. The certificate of
- 7 reaccreditation shall authorize the person to perform
- 8 asbestos-related work in A school -buildings BUILDING OR A
- 9 PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING in this state for a period of 1
- 10 year after its issuance.
- 11 Sec. 6. (1) The initial training courses, examinations,
- 12 -and refresher training courses, AND CERTIFICATES OF SUCCESSFUL
- 13 COURSE COMPLETION required pursuant to UNDER this act shall be
- 14 -conducted PROVIDED by the department or a person approved by
- 15 the department to sponsor the training and examinations AND ISSUE
- 16 THE CERTIFICATES OF SUCCESSFUL COURSE COMPLETION OF A TRAINING
- 17 COURSE in accordance with the initial training, -the- examina-
- 18 tions, and the refresher training course CONTINUING EDUCATION
- 19 components, AND THE CERTIFICATE ISSUANCE REQUIREMENTS of the
- 20 -EPA ASBESTOS model -contractor accreditation plan. -for states
- 21 found in appendix C of subpart E of part 763 of title 40 of the
- 22 code of federal regulations.
- 23 (2) THE DEPARTMENT MAY DENY, WITHDRAW, OR SUSPEND APPROVAL
- 24 OF A PERSON SEEKING APPROVAL OR APPROVED UNDER THIS ACT FOR 1 OR
- 25 MORE OF THE FOLLOWING REASONS:
- 26 (A) MISREPRESENTATION OF THE EXTENT OF DEPARTMENT APPROVAL
- 27 OF A TRAINING COURSE.

- (B) FAILURE TO SUBMIT REQUIRED INFORMATION OR NOTIFICATIONS
  2 IN A TIMELY MANNER.
- 3 (C) FAILURE TO MAINTAIN RECORDS REQUIRED BY LAW.
- 4 (D) FALSIFICATION OF ACCREDITATION RECORDS, INSTRUCTOR QUAL-
- 5 IFICATIONS, OR OTHER ACCREDITATION INFORMATION.
- 6 (E) FAILURE TO ADHERE TO THE TRAINING STANDARDS AND REQUIRE-
- 7 MENTS OF THIS ACT OR OF THE ASBESTOS MODEL ACCREDITATION PLAN.
- 8 Sec. 7. The following minimum experience shall be IS
- 9 required of all persons A PERSON seeking accreditation as AN
- 10 asbestos inspectors INSPECTOR, management planners PLANNER,
- 11 or project -designers DESIGNER:
- 12 (a) -Asbestos inspectors AN ASBESTOS INSPECTOR shall pos-
- 13 sess either of the following:
- (i) Not less than 1 year of experience in asbestos-related
- 15 work OR IN GENERAL BUILDING INSPECTIONS RELATED TO ENVIRONMENTAL
- 16 AND HEALTH CONCERNS.
- 17 (ii) Not less than 5 years of supervisory experience in
- 18 school building OR PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING operations and
- 19 maintenance.
- 20 (b) Asbestos BOTH AN ASBESTOS management planners
- 21 PLANNER and AN asbestos abatement project designers DESIGNER
- 22 shall possess either of the following:
- 23 (i) Not less than 2 years of experience in asbestos-related
- 24 work.
- 25 (ii) Not less than 5 years of supervisory experience in
- 26 school building OR PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING operations and
- 27 maintenance.

- Sec. 9. (1) The department, on its own initiative, or upon the written complaint of an aggrieved party, a state agency, or political subdivision, may investigate the acts of a person accredited under this act. The department may deny, suspend, or revoke a certificate of accreditation or reaccreditation under this act pursuant to UNDER the administrative procedures act of 1969, Act No. 306 of the Public Acts of 1969, being sections 24.201 to 24.328 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, if a person is 9 found not to be in compliance with this act or other applicable 10 state or federal laws.
- (2) The department may deny, suspend, or revoke a certifi
  12 cate of accreditation or reaccreditation for any 1 OR MORE of

  13 the following REASONS:
- (a) Willful A WILLFUL or negligent actions ACTION in

  15 violation of this act or other state or federal laws pertaining

  16 to the public health and safety aspects of asbestos-related work

  17 in A school buildings BUILDING OR A PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL

  18 BUILDING.
- (b) Falsification of records.
- 20 (c) Failure to obtain or renew a certificate of
  21 accreditation.
- (d) Deliberate misrepresentation in applying for accreditation.
- (e) Permitting any A person who has not received the
  proper training or accreditation under this act to be responsible
  for asbestos-related work in A school buildings BUILDING OR A
  PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING.

- (F) PERMITTING THE DUPLICATION OR USE OF ONE'S OWN
- 2 ACCREDITATION CERTIFICATE BY ANOTHER.
- 3 (G) OBTAINING ACCREDITATION FROM A TRAINING PROVIDER THAT
- 4 DOES NOT HAVE APPROVAL TO OFFER TRAINING FOR THAT PARTICULAR DIS-
- 5 CIPLINE FROM EITHER THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY OR A
- 6 STATE THAT HAS AN APPROVAL PROGRAM AS STRINGENT AS THIS ACT.
- 7 Sec. 10. (1) The department shall seek to obtain written
- 8 reciprocal agreements with other states -which THAT have accred-
- 9 itation and reaccreditation requirements which are equal to
- 10 THAT EQUAL or exceed the requirements of this act for persons
- 11 who perform A PERSON WHO PERFORMS asbestos-related work in A
- 12 school -buildings- BUILDING OR A PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING.
- (2) Following the department's execution of a written recip-
- 14 rocal agreement with another state, a person who has been prop-
- 15 erly accredited by that state shall not be required to receive
- 16 the initial training or take the examination to receive a certif-
- 17 icate of accreditation -pursuant to- REQUIRED BY this act to per-
- 18 form asbestos-related work in A school -buildings BUILDING OR A
- 19 PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING in this state. That person shall
- 20 submit a certificate of successful completion of training from
- 21 the other state and the fee as required by section 14.
- 22 (3) Reaccreditation pursuant to FOR A PERSON DESCRIBED IN
- 23 SUBSECTION (2), REACCREDITATION UNDER sections 4 and 5 may only
- 24 be obtained by submitting a copy of the certificate of successful
- 25 completion of a refresher training course from another state and
- 26 the fee as required by section 14.

- Sec. 11. (1) A person desiring to sponsor a training course
- 2 or refresher training course for those disciplines required to be
- 3 accredited under this act may apply for department approval on
- 4 forms supplied by the department. The department shall approve a
- 5 training course or a refresher training course that meets the
- 6 requirements for the course as prescribed by section 6.
- 7 (2) An applicant desiring to sponsor a training course shall
- 8 submit a fee of \$400.00 and shall supply all of the following
- 9 information AND FEES to the department:
- (a) The course sponsor's name, address, and telephone
- 11 number.
- (b) A list of any states that currently approve the training
- 13 course, including information as to whether the training course
- 14 has been approved by the United States environmental protection
- 15 agency.
- (c) The course curriculum.
- (d) A letter from the training course sponsor clearly indi-
- 18 cating compliance of the course with the requirements of this act
- 19 for all of the following:
- 20 (i) The length of training in days.
- 21 (ii) The amount and type of hands-on training.
- 22 (iii) The length, format, and passing score of the
- 23 examination.
- 24 (iv) The topics covered in the course.
- (e) A copy of all course materials, including student manu-
- 26 als, instructor notebooks, handouts, and any ALL other
- 27 materials that the department may request.

- (f) A detailed statement about the development of the
  2 examination used in the course.
- 3 (g) The names and qualifications of course instructors.
- 4 (h) A description and example of the certificate of success-
- 5 ful course completion issued to students who attend the course
- 6 and pass the examination THAT SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE
- 7 ASBESTOS MODEL ACCREDITATION PLAN.
- 8 (I) AN INITIAL APPLICATION FEE OF \$400.00 AND, AFTER THE
- 9 INITIAL YEAR, AN ANNUAL RENEWAL FEE OF \$200.00.
- 10 (3) An applicant desiring to sponsor a refresher training
- 11 course in any of the disciplines A DISCIPLINE required to be
- 12 accredited under this act shall supply all of the following
- 13 information to the department:
- (a) The length of training.
- (b) The topics covered in the course.
- (c) A copy of all course materials.
- 17 (d) The names and qualifications of course instructors.
- (e) A description and an example of the certificate of suc-
- 19 cessful completion of the training course issued to students who
- 20 complete the refresher training course THAT SATISFIES THE
- 21 REQUIREMENTS OF THE ASBESTOS MODEL ACCREDITATION PLAN.
- 22 (4) Within 60 days after receipt of the appropriate fee and
- 23 a complete application from a person desiring to sponsor training
- 24 courses as specified in this section, the department shall make a
- 25 determination as to the approval or denial of the application and
- 26 shall notify the applicant in writing of its determination.

- (5) Instructors of courses THE INSTRUCTOR OF A COURSE 2 offered under this section shall have academic credentials or 3 field experience, or both, in asbestos abatement.
- Sec. 12. (1) A TRAINING COURSE SPONSOR SHALL SUBMIT TO THE
  DEPARTMENT A NOTICE OF SCHEDULED COURSES NOT LESS THAN 7 CALENDAR
  DAYS BEFORE THE START OF THOSE COURSES, INDICATING STARTING AND
  RINDING DATES AND TIMES, LOCATION, AND INSTRUCTORS. A TRAINING
  COURSE SPONSOR SHALL ALSO ADVISE THE DEPARTMENT OF CANCELLATION
- 9 OF A COURSE NO LESS THAN 1 DAY BEFORE THE INDICATED START DATE OF 10 THAT COURSE.
- 12 shall permit department representatives, as part of a training
  13 course inspection, to attend, evaluate, and monitor any A
  14 training course without charge to the department. The department
  15 shall not provide advance notice of a training course
  16 inspection. The department may revoke or suspend approval of a
  17 training course if the inspection of a field site, conducted
  18 pursuant to— UNDER a training course inspection, indicates that
  19 a training course is not in compliance with the requirements of
  20 section 6.
- 21 (3) A TRAINING COURSE SPONSOR SHALL SATISFY THE

- (2) Failure to submit the annual fee as prescribed by sub12 section (1) as part of the application for accreditation consti13 tutes just cause for the director to deny issuance to a person of
  14 a certificate of accreditation or reaccreditation pursuant to
  15 UNDER section 13.
- (3) All fees collected by the department pursuant to UNDER 17 subsection (1) shall be deposited in the asbestos abatement fund 18 created in section -222- 220 of the asbestos abatement contractors licensing act, Act No. 135 of the Public Acts of 1986, BEING 20 SECTION 338.3220 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.
- Sec. 15. A person who is accredited under this act to per22 form asbestos-related work in A school buildings—BUILDING OR A
  23 PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING shall have his or her initial and
  24 current certificate of accreditation or reaccreditation at the
  25 location where he or she is conducting asbestos-related work. A
  26 person's failure to have his or her certificate of accreditation
  27 or reaccreditation at the job site where he or she is working may

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- 1 result in the suspension or revocation of that person's
- 2 certificate of accreditation.
- 3 Section 2. Section 16 of Act No. 440 of the Public Acts of
