THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Section 11a of Act No. 303 of the Public Acts of
 1967, as added by Act No. 494 of the Public Acts of 1988, being
 section 281.1011a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to
 read as follows:

5 Sec. 11a. (1) The marine safety education commission is 6 created in the department. The commission shall be administered 7 by the recreation division of the department of natural 8 resources. The commission shall consist of the following 9 members:

(a) The director or his or her designee.

2 (b) The director of the department of state police or his or3 her designee.

4 (c) The superintendent of public instruction or his or her5 designee.

6 (d) Twelve individuals appointed by the governor with the7 advice and consent of the senate as follows:

8 (i) One individual recommended by the Michigan sheriffs'9 association.

10 (*ii*) One individual recommended by the state boating law11 administrator.

12 (*iii*) One individual recommended by the United States power13 squadrons.

14 (*iv*) One individual recommended by the United States coast
15 guard auxiliary.

16 (v) One individual recommended by the American national red 17 cross.

18 (vi) One individual recommended by the Michigan boating
19 industries association.

(vii) One individual recommended by the national marine manufacturers association.

22 -(viii) One individual recommended by the Michigan consumers
23 council.

24 (viii) - (ix) One individual from a county marine safety 25 division.

26 (ix) - (x) Three individuals from the general public.

1 (x) (xi) One individual recommended by the Michigan 2 association of counties.

3 (2) At least 4 of the individuals appointed by the governor4 in subsection (1) shall be women.

5 (3) The members of the commission shall serve without com-6 pensation, but shall be entitled to actual and necessary travel 7 and other expenses incurred in the performance of official 8 duties.

9 (4) The commission shall select a chairperson from among its10 members.

11 (5) The department shall supply clerical staff as needed by 12 the commission.

13 (6) The commission shall meet at least once a year in the14 fall at the call of the chairperson of the commission.

15 (7) A majority of the members of the commission shall con-16 stitute a quorum for the transaction of business at a meeting of 17 the commission. Action by the commission shall be by a majority 18 of the votes cast.

19 (8) The commission shall review boating accidents on
20 Michigan waters and study the development of marine safety educa21 tion programs and other policies of state government relating to
22 marine safety. The commission shall report to the department on
23 its findings and shall recommend to the department changes to
24 policies and programs.

(9) As used in this section, "commission" means the marine26 safety education commission.
