

SENATE BILL No. 507

May 4, 1995, Introduced by Senators STEIL, GAST, GEAKE, DUNASKISS, GOUGEON, CARL, CISKY and NORTH and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend the title and sections 2, 4, and 6 of Act No. 540 of the Public Acts of 1982, entitled as amended "Library of Michigan act,"

sections 2 and 6 as amended by Act No. 114 of the Public Acts of 1983 and section 4 as amended by Act No. 98 of the Public Acts of 1986, being sections 397.12, 397.14, and 397.16 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. The title and sections 2, 4, and 6 of Act
- 2 No. 540 of the Public Acts of 1982, sections 2 and 6 as amended
- 3 by Act No. 114 of the Public Acts of 1983 and section 4 as
- 4 amended by Act No. 98 of the Public Acts of 1986, being sections
- 5 397.12, 397.14, and 397.16 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:

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1 TITLE

- 2 An act to create the library of Michigan; to create a board
- 3 of trustees for the library; to establish the qualifications of
- 4 the state librarian; to provide the powers and duties of the
- 5 board of trustees, the legislative council, THE COUNCIL
- 6 ADMINISTRATOR, the director of the legislative service bureau,
- 7 the state librarian, and certain state officials and agencies;
- 8 and to repeal -certain acts and parts of acts.
- 9 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- (a) "Board" means the board of trustees of the library cre-
- 11 ated in section 4.
- (b) "Council" means the legislative council established
- 13 under section 15 of article IV of the state constitution of
- 14 1963.
- (c) "Director" means the director of the legislative serv-
- 16 ice bureau "COUNCIL ADMINISTRATOR" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN
- 17 SECTION 102 OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT, ACT NO. 268 OF THE
- 18 PUBLIC ACTS OF 1986, BEING SECTION 4.1102 OF THE MICHIGAN
- 19 COMPILED LAWS.
- (d) "Library" means the library of Michigan.
- 21 Sec. 4. (1) A board of trustees of the library is created
- 22 within the legislative branch of state government. The board
- 23 shall make budget recommendations to the council to be submitted
- 24 to the house and senate appropriations committees as part of the
- 25 total budget recommendations for the legislative council, and
- 26 shall make recommendations to the council on the following
- 27 matters:

- 1 (a) The services the library shall provide.
- 2 (b) The manner in which the services shall be provided.
- 3 (c) Other matters of general policy concerning the library.
- 4 (2) The board shall meet not less than 3 times per year,
- 5 including a meeting to be held in January of each year. The
- 6 board shall meet also at the call of the chairperson of the 7 board.
- 8 (3) The board shall consist of the following:
- 9 (a) Four legislators appointed by the council, 1 from the 10 majority party and 1 from the minority party in each house.
- (b) A representative of the Michigan library association to
 12 be appointed by the governor from a list of 3 persons nominated
 13 by the Michigan library association.
- (c) Two members of the general public who represent users of the state library to be appointed by the governor.
- (d) One member who is a librarian from a college or univer17 sity library to be appointed by the governor.
- (e) One member who is a librarian from a public or private K
 19 to 12 system to be appointed by the governor.
- 20 (f) Two members who are librarians from public libraries to
 21 be appointed by the governor.
- (g) One member who is a librarian from a special library tobe appointed by the governor.
- (h) One member who is a librarian from a state agency
- 25 library to be appointed by the governor.
- (i) The chief justice of the supreme court or a designee ofthe supreme court.

- 1 (j) The <u>director of the legislative service bureau</u> COUNCIL
 2 ADMINISTRATOR.
- 3 (4) Members appointed to the board by the council shall hold
- 4 office for a term of 2 years to coincide with the terms of office
- 5 of state representatives. Members appointed to the board by the
- 6 governor shall hold office for a term of 3 years except that of
- 7 the members first appointed, 3 shall be appointed for 3 years,
- 8 3 for 2 years, and 3 for 1 year.
- 9 (5) The board shall prescribe rules for its own procedure.
- 10 Annually, the board shall elect from its membership a chairperson
- 11 and vice-chairperson. Members shall serve without compensation
- 12 but shall be entitled to reasonable and necessary expenses
- 13 incurred in the discharge of their duties.
- 14 (6) The state librarian shall serve as secretary of the 15 board.
- Sec. 6. (1) The state librarian shall have care and charge
- 17 of the library, the administrative functions of the library, and
- 18 all budgeting functions of the library. The -director COUNCIL
- 19 ADMINISTRATOR and state librarian shall coordinate the activities
- 20 of the library with the legislative council.
- 21 (2) The state librarian shall be a graduate with a master's
- 22 degree in library science and shall have not less than 4 years'
- 23 experience in library work in an administrative capacity. Each
- 24 assistant state librarian shall be a graduate with a master's
- 25 degree in library science.

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
