

## **SENATE BILL No. 579**

June 7, 1995, Introduced by Senators BOUCHARD and CISKY and referred to the Committee on Local, Urban and State Affairs.

A bill to amend section 3 of Act No. 203 of the Public Acts of 1965, entitled

"Michigan law enforcement officers training council act of 1965," being section 28.603 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 3 of Act No. 203 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1965, being section 28.603 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 3. (1) There is created the THE law enforcement
- 5 council IS CREATED to carry out the intent of this act and to
- 6 consist of -11 12 members selected as follows:
- 7 (a) The attorney general, or his OR HER designated
- 8 representative.
- 9 (b) The commissioner of state police, or his OR HER
- 10 designated representative.

- 1 (c) Three members appointed to the council by the governor
- 2 from a list of 6 active members submitted by the Michigan associ-
- 3 ation of chiefs of police.
- 4 (d) Three members appointed to the council by the governor
- 5 from a list of 6 active law enforcement officials submitted by
- 6 the Michigan sheriffs association.
- 7 (e) One member appointed to the council by the governor from
- 8 a list of 3 names submitted by the fraternal order of the
- 9 police.
- 10 (f) One member appointed to the council by the governor from
- 11 a list of 3 names submitted by the metropolitan club.
- (g) One member appointed to the council by the governor from
- 13 a list of 3 names submitted by the Detroit police officers
- 14 associations ASSOCIATION.
- 15 (H) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED TO THE COUNCIL BY THE GOVERNOR WHO
- 16 REPRESENTS AN ORGANIZATION THAT IS NOT LISTED IN SUBDIVISIONS (C)
- 17 TO (G).
- 18 (2) (2) (2) All appointments made by the governor shall be
- 19 UNDER THIS ACT ARE subject to the advice and consent of the
- 20 senate.
