

## **SENATE BILL No. 630**

## September 12, 1995, Introduced by Senator DE BEAUSSAERT and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 8122 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, entitled as amended

"Revised judicature act of 1961,"

as amended by Act No. 135 of the Public Acts of 1988, being section 600.8122 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Section 8122 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts
 of 1961, as amended by Act No. 135 of the Public Acts of 1988,
 being section 600.8122 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended
 to read as follows:

5 Sec. 8122. (1) The thirty-seventh district consists of the 6 cities of Warren and Center Line, is a district of the third 7 class, and has 4 judges.

(2) The thirty-eighth district consists of the city of -East
 2 Detroit EASTPOINTE, is a district of the third class, and has 1
 3 judge.

4 (3) The thirty-ninth district consists of the cities of
5 Roseville and Fraser, is a district of the third class, and has
6 -2 - 3 judges. Subject to section 8175, this district may have -1
7 additional judge effective January 1, 1989. If a new office of
8 judge is added to this district to be filled by election in 1988,
9 the term of office of the judge for that election only shall be 4
10 years.

(4) The fortieth district consists of the city of Saint
12 Clair Shores, is a district of the third class, and has 2
13 judges.

14 (5) The forty-first-a district consists of the cities of
15 Utica and Sterling Heights and the townships of Shelby and Macomb
16 in the county of Macomb, is a district of the third class, and
17 has 4 judges.

(6) The forty-first-b district consists of the city of Mt.
19 Clemens and the townships of Clinton and Harrison in the county
20 of Macomb, is a district of the third class, and has -2- 3
21 judges. -Subject to section 8175, this district may have 1 addi22 tional judge effective January 1, 1989. If a new office of judge
23 is added to this district to be filled by election in 1980, the
24 term of office of the judge for that election only shall be 4
25 years.

26 (7) -The EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (8)
27 AND (9), THE forty-second district consists of the cities of

1 Memphis, Richmond, and New Baltimore and the townships of Bruce, 2 Washington, Armada, Ray, Richmond, Lenox, and Chesterfield in the 3 county of Macomb, is a district of the second class, and is 4 divided into the following election divisions:

5 (a) The first division consists of the cities of Memphis and 6 Richmond and the townships of Bruce, Washington, Armada, Ray, and 7 Richmond and has 1 judge.

8 (b) The second division consists of the city of New
9 Baltimore and the townships of Lenox and Chesterfield and has 1
10 judge.

(8) IF THE COUNTY OF MACOMB APPROVES THE REFORMATION OF THE
PORTY-SECOND DISTRICT PURSUANT TO LAW, AND THE CITY OF NEW
BALTIMORE AND THE TOWNSHIPS OF LENOX AND CHESTERFIELD IN THE
COUNTY OF MACOMB APPROVE THE CREATION OF THE FORTY-SECOND-A DISTRICT PURSUANT TO LAW, THE FORTY-SECOND DISTRICT CONSISTS OF THE
CITIES OF MEMPHIS AND RICHMOND AND THE TOWNSHIPS OF BRUCE,
WASHINGTON, ARMADA, RAY, AND RICHMOND IN THE COUNTY OF MACOMB, IS
A DISTRICT OF THE SECOND CLASS, AND HAS 1 JUDGE.

(9) IF THE COUNTY OF MACOMB APPROVES THE REFORMATION OF THE
20 FORTY-SECOND DISTRICT PURSUANT TO LAW, AND THE CITY OF NEW
21 BALTIMORE AND THE TOWNSHIPS OF LENOX AND CHESTERFIELD IN THE
22 COUNTY OF MACOMB APPROVE THE CREATION OF THE FORTY-SECOND-A DIS23 TRICT PURSUANT TO LAW, THE FORTY-SECOND-A DISTRICT CONSISTS OF
24 THE CITY OF NEW BALTIMORE AND THE TOWNSHIPS OF LENOX AND
25 CHESTERFIELD IN THE COUNTY OF MACOMB, IS A DISTRICT OF THE THIRD
26 CLASS, AND HAS 1 JUDGE.

Section 2. The reformation of the forty-second district and the creation of the forty-second-a district, as allowed by this 3 1995 amendatory act, shall not take place unless resolutions of 4 approval by the governing bodies of the county of Macomb, the 5 city of New Baltimore, and the townships of Lenox and 6 Chesterfield, as required by section 8176 of the revised judica-7 ture act of 1961, Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, being 8 section 600.8176 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are filed with 9 the state court administrator not later than April 30, 1996.
