

## **SENATE BILL No. 647**

September 13, 1995, Introduced by Senator HONIGMAN and referred to the Committee on Local, Urban and State Affairs.

A bill to amend section 8 of Act No. 87 of the Public Acts of 1855, entitled

"An act relative to burying grounds; and to impose certain duties upon the department of commerce,"

being section 456.8 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Section 8 of Act No. 87 of the Public Acts of
 2 1855, being section 456.8 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
 3 amended to read as follows:

Sec. 8. Any 7 or more persons who <u>shall</u> meet in pursuance of <u>such</u> THE notice DESCRIBED IN SECTION 7 may elect by
ballot a board of trustees consisting of AT LEAST 9 BUT NOT MORE
THAN 12 members. <u>, 3</u> OF THE MEMBERS FIRST ELECTED, 1/3 SHALL
8 SERVE for 1 year, <u>3</u> 1/3 for 2 years, and <u>3</u> 1/3 for 3 years.
<u>, and at</u> AT each annual meeting thereafter, <u>3</u> 1/3 OF THE

1 trustees shall be elected by ballot, who AND THEY shall hold 2 their office for 3 years and until their successors shall-be 3 ARE elected and have filed their acceptance. -: Provided, That-4 HOWEVER, if any corporation now organized under this act shall 5 have HAS any trustees whose term of office shall DOES not 6 expire at the date of its next annual meeting, it shall then 7 elect only such THE number of trustees as shall THAT WILL 8 increase its board to AT LEAST 9 BUT NOT MORE THAN 12 members. 9 At any such THE election, the -3 persons having the highest 10 number of votes for trustees TRUSTEE shall be deemed 11 CONSIDERED elected.
