

## SENATE BILL No. 758

## November 28, 1995, Introduced by Senator CONROY and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Tourism.

A bill to amend section 19a of Act No. 300 of the Public

Acts of 1949, entitled as amended

"Michigan vehicle code,"

as amended by Act No. 432 of the Public Acts of 1994, being section 257.19a of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Section 19a of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of
 1949, as amended by Act No. 432 of the Public Acts of 1994, being
 section 257.19a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
 as follows:

5 Sec. 19a. "Handicapper" means a person who is determined by
6 a physician OR AN OPTOMETRIST AS SPECIFICALLY PROVIDED IN THIS
7 SECTION licensed to practice in this state to have 1 or more of
8 the following -physicial PHYSICAL characteristics:

(a) Blindness AS DETERMINED BY AN OPTOMETRIST OR A
 PHYSICIAN.

3 (b) Inability to walk more than 200 feet without having to4 stop and rest.

5 (c) Inability to do both of the following:

6 (i) Use 1 or both legs or feet.

7 (*ii*) Walk without the use of a wheelchair, walker, crutch,
8 brace, prosthetic, or other device, or without the assistance of
9 another person.

(d) A lung disease from which the person's forced expiratory volume for 1 second, when measured by spirometry, is less than 1 liter, or from which the person's arterial oxygen tension is less than 60 mm/hg of room air at rest.

(e) A cardiovascular condition that causes the person to
measure between 3 and 4 on the New York heart classification
scale, or that renders the person incapable of meeting a minimum
standard for cardiovascular health that is established by the
American heart association and approved by the department of
public health.

(f) An arthritic, neurological, or orthopedic condition that
21 severely limits the person's ability to walk.

(g) The persistent reliance upon an oxygen source other thanordinary air.
