## **SENATE BILL No. 795**

## December 6, 1995, Introduced by Senators KOIVISTO, BERRYMAN, CHERRY, MILLER and YOUNG and referred to the Committee on Local, Urban and State Affairs.

A bill to authorize the department of state police to convey certain state owned property in Iron county; to prescribe conditions for the conveyance; and to provide for the disposition of revenue derived from the conveyance.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1. The department of state police, on behalf of the
 state, may convey to Iron county, for the consideration of \$1.00,
 property located in the Bates township, Iron county, Michigan,
 and described as follows:

A parcel of land lying in the N1/2 of the SW1/4 of Section
22, Township 43 North, Range 34 West, described as follows:
Commencing at the West quarter-corner of said Section 22,
Township 43 North, Range 34 West; thence South 62 degrees 45'
East a distance of 1128.54 feet to the point of beginning; thence

North 88 degrees 51' East a distance of 350.00 feet; thence South
 1 degree 09' East a distance of 400.00 feet to the North
 right-of-way line of U.S. 2; thence South 88 degrees 51' West
 along the North right-of-way line of U.S. 2 a distance of 350.00
 feet; thence North 1 degree 09' West a distance of 400.00 feet to
 the point of beginning.

7 Sec. 2. The conveyance authorized by this act shall be by8 quitclaim deed approved by the attorney general.

9 Sec. 3. The revenue received under this act shall be depos-10 ited in the state treasury and credited to the general fund.
