

SENATE BILL No. 997

May 2, 1996, Introduced by Senator NORTH and referred to the Committee on Local, Urban and State Affairs.

A bill to authorize the state administrative board to convey certain state owned property in Chippewa county; to prescribe conditions for the conveyance; and to provide for disposition of the revenue derived from the conveyance.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) The state administrative board, on behalf of
- 2 the state, may convey to Chippewa soil conservation district, for
- 3 consideration of not less than fair market value as determined
- 4 pursuant to subsection (2), property under the jurisdiction of
- 5 the department of agriculture and located in the township of
- 6 Dafter, Chippewa county, Michigan, and further described as
- 7 follows:
- 8 The NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 7 and the SW 1/4 of the
- 9 NW 1/4 of Section 8, T46N, R1W, Dafter Township, Chippewa
- 10 County.

- (2) The fair market value of the property described in
- 2 subsection (1) shall be determined by an appraisal based on the
- 3 property's highest and best use, as prepared by the state tax
- 4 commission or an independent fee appraiser.
- 5 (3) The description of the parcel in subsection (1) is
- 6 approximate and for purposes of the conveyance is subject to
- 7 adjustment as the state administrative board or attorney general
- 8 considers necessary by survey or other legal description.
- 9 (4) The conveyance authorized by this act shall be by quit-
- 10 claim deed approved by the attorney general and shall reserve to
- 11 the state all rights to coal, oil, gas, and other minerals,
- 12 excluding sand, gravel, clay, or other nonmetallic minerals found
- 13 on or under the property conveyed.
- 14 (5) The revenue received under this act shall be deposited
- 15 in the state treasury and credited to the general fund.
