

## **SENATE BILL No. 1031**

May 15, 1996, Introduced by Senators SHUGARS, SCHUETTE, GOUGEON, STALLINGS, A. SMITH and MC MANUS and referred to the Committee on Economic Development, International Trade and Regulatory Affairs.

A bill to amend Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, entitled

"Natural resources and environmental protection act," as amended, being sections 324.101 to 324.90106 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding part 8.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, as
- 2 amended, being sections 324.101 to 324.90106 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding part 8 to read as follows:
- 4 PART 8 SENIOR AND YOUTH ENVIRONMENTAL CORPS
- 5 SEC. 801. AS USED IN THIS PART:
- 6 (A) "AGENCY" MEANS | OF THE AGENCIES OR ORGANIZATIONS PAR-
- 7 TICIPATING IN THE ACTIVITIES OF THE SENIOR AND YOUTH
- 8 ENVIRONMENTAL CORPS.

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- (B) "COORDINATOR" MEANS THE PERSON DESIGNATED BY THE
- 2 DIRECTOR WITH THE ADVICE OF THE COUNCIL TO ADMINISTER THE
- 3 ACTIVITIES OF THE SENIOR AND YOUTH ENVIRONMENTAL CORPS.
- 4 (C) "CORPS" MEANS THE SENIOR AND YOUTH ENVIRONMENTAL CORPS.
- 5 (D) "COUNCIL" MEANS THE SENIOR AND YOUTH ENVIRONMENTAL CORPS
- 6 COORDINATING COUNCIL.
- 7 (E) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
- 8 OUALITY.
- 9 (F) "DIRECTOR" MEANS THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OR HIS
- 10 OR HER AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE.
- (G) "SENIOR" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS 55 YEARS OF AGE OR
  12 OVER.
- (H) "VOLUNTEER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS WILLING TO WORK
- 14 WITHOUT EXPECTATION OF SALARY OR FINANCIAL REWARD, AND WHO
- 15 CHOOSES WHERE HE OR SHE PROVIDES SERVICES AND THE TYPE OF SERV-
- 16 ICES HE OR SHE PROVIDES.
- 17 (I) "YOUTH" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS 17 YEARS OF AGE OR 18 UNDER.
- 19 SEC. 802. THE SENIOR ENVIRONMENTAL CORPS IS CREATED WITHIN
- 20 THE DEPARTMENT. THE DEPARTMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL
- 21 RESOURCES SHALL PARTICIPATE IN THE ADMINISTRATION AND IMPLEMENTA-
- 22 TION OF THE CORPS AND SHALL APPOINT REPRESENTATIVES TO THE
- 23 COUNCIL.
- 24 SEC. 803. THE CORPS SHALL DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 25 (A) PROVIDE RESOURCES AND A SUPPORT STRUCTURE TO FACILITATE
- 26 CORPS ACTIVITIES AND ACCOMPLISH GOALS.

- 1 (B) CARRY OUT PROFESSIONAL AND PARAPROFESSIONAL PROJECTS
- 2 THAT FOCUS ON CONSERVATION, PROTECTION, REHABILITATION, AND
- 3 ENHANCEMENT OF THE STATE'S NATURAL, ENVIRONMENTAL, AND RECREA-
- 4 TIONAL RESOURCES AND THAT OTHERWISE WOULD NOT BE IMPLEMENTED
- 5 BECAUSE OF LIMITED FINANCIAL RESOURCES.
- 6 (C) PROVIDE MEANINGFUL OPPORTUNITIES FOR SENIOR VOLUNTEERS
- 7 TO CONTINUE TO UTILIZE THEIR PROFESSIONAL TRAINING, LIFELONG
- 8 SKILLS, ABILITIES, EXPERIENCE, AND WISDOM THROUGH PARTICIPATION
- 9 IN CORPS PROJECTS.
- 10 (D) PROVIDE MEANINGFUL OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUTH VOLUNTEERS TO
- II GAIN EXPERIENCE AND DEVELOP SKILLS THROUGH PARTICIPATION IN CORPS
- 12 PROJECTS.
- (E) ASSIST AGENCIES IN CARRYING OUT STATUTORY ASSIGNMENTS
- 14 WITH LIMITED FUNDING RESOURCES.
- 15 (F) ENHANCE COMMUNITY UNDERSTANDING OF ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES
- 16 THROUGH EDUCATIONAL OUTREACH.
- 17 (G) ENHANCE THE STATE'S ABILITY TO PROVIDE NEEDED PUBLIC
- 18 SERVICES IN BOTH URBAN AND RURAL SETTINGS.
- 19 SEC. 804. (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONVENE A SENIOR AND
- 20 YOUTH ENVIRONMENTAL CORPS COORDINATING COUNCIL TO MEET AS NEEDED
- 21 TO DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 22 (A) ESTABLISH AND ASSESS POLICIES.
- 23 (B) DEFINE STANDARDS FOR PROJECTS.
- 24 (C) EVALUATE AND SELECT PROJECTS.
- 25 (D) DEVELOP RECRUITMENT, TRAINING, AND PLACEMENT
- 26 PROCEDURES.

- I (E) RECEIVE AND REVIEW PROJECT STATUS AND COMPLETION
- 2 REPORTS.
- 3 (F) PROVIDE FOR RECOGNITION OF VOLUNTEER ACTIVITY.
- 4 (2) THE COUNCIL SHALL INCLUDE REPRESENTATIVES APPOINTED BY
- 5 THE DEPARTMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES. THE
- 6 COUNCIL SHALL DEVELOP BYLAWS, POLICIES, AND PROCEDURES TO GOVERN
- 7 ITS ACTIVITIES. THE COUNCIL SHALL ADVISE THE DIRECTOR ON DISTRI-
- 8 BUTION OF AVAILABLE FUNDING FOR CORPS ACTIVITIES.
- 9 (3) THE COUNCIL SHALL INCLUDE A REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE
- 10 DEPARTMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.
- 11 SEC. 805. (1) CONTINGENT UPON AVAILABLE FUNDING, THE
- 12 DEPARTMENT SHALL DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- (A) PROVIDE A COORDINATOR AND STAFF SUPPORT TO THE COUNCIL
- 14 AS NEEDED.
- 15 (B) PROVIDE SUPPORT TO THE AGENCIES FOR RECRUITMENT OF
- 16 VOLUNTEERS.
- 17 (C) DEVELOP A BUDGET AND ALLOCATE AVAILABLE FUNDS WITH THE
- 18 ADVICE OF THE COUNCIL.
- (D) DEVELOP A WRITTEN VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT.
- 20 (E) COLLECT AND MAINTAIN PROJECT AND VOLUNTEER RECORDS.
- 21 (F) PROVIDE REPORTS TO THE STATE LEGISLATURE AND THE COUNCIL
- 22 AS REQUESTED.
- 23 (G) PROVIDE AGENCY PROJECT MANAGERS AND VOLUNTEERS WITH ORI-
- 24 ENTATION TO THE CORPS PROGRAM AND TRAINING IN THE USE OF
- 25 VOLUNTEERS.

- I (H) ACT AS A LIAISON WITH AND PROVIDE INFORMATION TO OTHER
- 2 STATES AND JURISDICTIONS ON THE CORPS PROGRAM AND PROGRAM
- 3 ACTIVITIES.
- 4 (I) DEVELOP PROJECT PROPOSALS.
- 5 (J) ADMINISTER PROJECT ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE AGENCY.
- 6 (K) DEVELOP APPROPRIATE PROCEDURES FOR THE USE OF
- 7 VOLUNTEERS.
- 8 (1) PROVIDE PROJECT ORIENTATION, TECHNICAL TRAINING, SAFETY
- 9 TRAINING, EQUIPMENT, AND SUPPLIES TO CARRY OUT PROJECT
- 10 ACTIVITIES.
- 11 (M) MAINTAIN PROJECT RECORDS AND PROVIDE PROJECT REPORTS.
- (N) APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT GRANTS OR CONTRIBUTIONS FOR CORPS
- 13 APPROVED PROJECTS.
- (O) WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE COUNCIL, ENTER INTO MEMORANDA
- 15 OF UNDERSTANDING AND COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS WITH FEDERAL, STATE,
- 16 AND LOCAL AGENCIES TO CARRY OUT CORPS APPROVED PROJECTS.
- 17 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT USE CORPS VOLUNTEERS TO DIS-
- 18 PLACE CURRENTLY EMPLOYED WORKERS.
- 19 SEC. 806. ALL VOLUNTEER ACTIVITY OF CORPS PARTICIPANTS
- 20 SHALL BE PERFORMED UNDER THE TERMS OF A WRITTEN MASTER AGREEMENT
- 21 APPROVED BY THE COUNCIL AND THE STATE ATTORNEY GENERAL. AT A
- 22 MINIMUM, THE VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT MUST INCLUDE A DESCRIPTION OF
- 23 THE WORK THAT THE VOLUNTEER IS TO PERFORM, INCLUDING THE STAN-
- 24 DARDS OF PERFORMANCE REQUIRED, ANY EXPENSES OR OTHER BENEFITS TO
- 25 WHICH THE VOLUNTEER IS TO BE ENTITLED, SUCH AS MILEAGE, LODGING,
- 26 UNIFORMS OR OTHER CLOTHING OR SUPPLIES, TRAINING OR OTHER SUPPORT
- 27 TO BE PROVIDED TO THE VOLUNTEER BY THE AGENCY, THE DURATION OF

1 THE AGREEMENT, AND THE TERMS UNDER WHICH THE AGREEMENT MAY BE 2 CANCELED.
