



# SENATE BILL No. 1076

July 3, 1996, Introduced by Senator CONROY and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend section 1147 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled as amended

"The school code of 1976,"

being section 380.1147 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1 Section 1. Section 1147 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts  
2 of 1976, being section 380.1147 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 1147. (1) A person ~~, resident of~~ WHO RESIDES IN a  
5 school district not maintaining a kindergarten and WHO IS at  
6 least 5 years of age on the first day of ~~enrollment of~~ the  
7 school year ~~, shall have a right to~~ MAY attend school in the  
8 SCHOOL district.

9 (2) In a school district ~~where provision is made for~~ THAT  
10 PROVIDES kindergarten, ~~work,~~ a child ~~, resident of the~~

1 ~~district, is entitled to~~ WHO RESIDES IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT MAY  
2 enroll in the kindergarten if the child is at least 5 years of  
3 age on ~~December 1~~ THE FIRST DAY of the school year of  
4 enrollment. In a school district ~~which~~ THAT has semiannual  
5 promotions, a child ~~, resident of the district, is entitled to~~  
6 WHO RESIDES IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT MAY enroll in kindergarten for  
7 the second semester if the child is at least 5 years of age on  
8 ~~March 1 of the year of enrollment~~ THE FIRST DAY OF THE SECOND  
9 SEMESTER.
