

## **SENATE BILL No. 1086**

July 3, 1996, Introduced by Senator A. SMITH and referred to the Committee on Human Resources, Labor and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to amend the title and section 2 of Act No. 469 of the Public Acts of 1980, entitled
"The whistleblowers' protection act,"
being section 15.362 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. The title and section 2 of Act No. 469 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1980, being section 15.362 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 4 TITLE
- An act to provide protection to employees who ARE SUSPECTED
- 6 BY EMPLOYERS OF REPORTING OR WHO report OR ARE ABOUT TO REPORT a
- 7 violation or suspected violation of state, local, or federal law;
- 8 to provide protection to employees who participate in hearings,
- 9 investigations, legislative inquiries, or court actions; and to
- 10 prescribe remedies and penalties.

- 1 Sec. 2. (1) An SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (2), AN employer
- 2 shall not discharge OR threaten AN EMPLOYEE, or -otherwise-
- 3 discriminate against an employee regarding the employee's compen-
- 4 sation, terms, conditions, location, or privileges of employment,
- 5 -because the- FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING REASONS:
- 6 (A) THE employee, or a person acting on behalf of the
- 7 employee, -reports or VERBALLY OR IN WRITING REPORTS TO A PUBLIC
- 8 BODY, is about to report TO A PUBLIC BODY, -verbally or in
- 9 writing, OR IS SUSPECTED BY THE EMPLOYER OF REPORTING OR BEING

- 11 lation of a law. or regulation or rule promulgated pursuant to
- 12 law of this state, a political subdivision of this state, or the
- 13 United States to a public body, unless the employee knows that
- 14 the report is false, or because an
- 15 (B) THE employee is requested by a public body to partici-
- 16 pate in A COURT ACTION OR an investigation, hearing, or inquiry
- 17 held by that THE public body. , or a court action.
- 18 (2) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT APPLY TO AN EMPLOYEE WHO KNOW-
- 19 INGLY MAKES OR EXPRESSES AN INTENT TO MAKE A FALSE REPORT TO A
- 20 PUBLIC BODY.
- 21 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "LAW" INCLUDES A STATUTE, RULE,
- 22 OR REGULATION ENACTED OR PROMULGATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAWS
- 23 OF THIS STATE, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE, OR THE
- 24 UNITED STATES.
