

## SENATE BILL No. 1088

July 3, 1996, Introduced by Senator A. SMITH and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend section 4 of Act No. 472 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled
"An act to regulate political activity; to regulate lobbyists, lobbyist agents, and lobbying activities; to require registration of lobbyists and lobbyist agents; to require the filing of reports; to prescribe the powers and duties of the department of state; to prescribe penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"
being section 4.414 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 unless consideration of equal or greater value is received
2 therefor. Gift does not include:
3 (a) A campaign contribution otherwise reported as required 4 by THE MICHIGAN CAMPAIGN FINANCE ACT, Act No, 388 of the Public 5 Acts of 1976, es-amented, being sections 169.201 to 169.282 of 6 the Michigan Compiled Laws.

7 (b) A loan made in the normal course of business by an 8 institution as defined in section 5 of THE BANKING CODE OF 1969, 9 Act No. 319 of the Public Acts of 1969, tasemended, being sec10 tion 487.305 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, a national bank, a 11 branch bank, an insurance company issuing a loan or receiving a 12 mortgage in the normal course of business, a premium finance com13 pany, a mortgage company, a small loan company, a state or fed14 eral credit union, a savings and loan association chartered by 15 this state or the federal government; or a licensee as defined by 16 THE MOTOR VEHICLE SALES FINANCE ACT, Act No. 27 of the Public

17 Acts of the Extra Session of 1950, as amended, being sections 18492.101 to 492.141 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
(c) A gift received from a member of the person's immediate 20 family, a relative of a spouse, a relative within the seventh 21 degree of consanguinity as computed by the civil law method, or 22 from the spouse of the relative.

(d) A breakfast, luncheon, dinner, or other refreshment consisting of food and beverage provided for immediate consumption.

3 (2) "Immediate family" means a child residing in an
4 individual's household, a spouse of an individual, or an individ5 ual claimed by that individual or that individual's spouse as a 6 dependent for federal income tax purposes. 7 (3) "Loan" means a transfer of money, property, or anything 8 of ascertainable value in exchange for an obligation, conditional 9 or not, to repay in whole or in part.
