

## SENATE BILL No. 1093

July 3, 1996, Introduced by Senator A. SMITH and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend section 4 of Act No. 380 of the Public Acts of 1965, entitled

"Executive organization act of 1965,"

being section 16.104 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 4 of Act No. 380 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1965, being section 16.104 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 4. (1) Except as otherwise provided by this act or
- 5 the state constitution, all executive and administrative powers,
- 6 duties, and functions, excepting those of the legislature and the
- 7 judiciary, previously vested by law in the several state depart-
- 8 ments, commissions, boards, officers, bureaus, divisions, or
- 9 other agencies are vested in the following principal
- 10 departments:

- 15 (14) If section 28 of article 5 of the state constitution
- 16 of 1963 is amended to provide for changing the name of the state

- 19 in this section, the name of the department shall be the
- 20 Department of State Highways and Transportation:

- 26 (S) DEPARTMENT OF MICHIGAN JOBS COMMISSION.

- 1 (2) A PERSON WHO PREPARES A DOCUMENT, REPORT, OR PUBLIC
- 2 RECORD THAT IS PAID FOR WITH FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY THE
- 3 LEGISLATURE TO A DEPARTMENT DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION SHALL PRO-
- 4 VIDE THAT DEPARTMENT WITH AT LEAST 1 COPY OF THE DOCUMENT,
- 5 REPORT, OR PUBLIC RECORD.
- 6 (3) IF A DEPARTMENT DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION POSSESSES A
- 7 DOCUMENT, REPORT, OR PUBLIC RECORD THAT WAS PAID FOR WITH FUNDS
- 8 APPROPRIATED BY THE LEGISLATURE TO THAT DEPARTMENT, THE DEPART-
- 9 MENT SHALL RETAIN AT LEAST 1 COPY OF THE DOCUMENT, REPORT, OR
- 10 PUBLIC RECORD BEFORE TRANSFERRING IT TO A PERSON EXEMPT FROM THE
- 11 FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT. A COPY MAY BE REPRODUCED AND MAIN-
- 12 TAINED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RECORDS MEDIA ACT, ACT NO. 116 OF
- 13 THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1992, BEING SECTIONS 24.401 TO 24.403 OF THE
- 14 MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.
- 15 (4) A DEPARTMENT THAT POSSESSES A COPY OF A DOCUMENT,
- 16 REPORT, OR PUBLIC RECORD PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2) OR (3) SHALL
- 17 MAINTAIN AND IF APPLICABLE DISPOSE OF THAT DOCUMENT, REPORT, OR
- 18 PUBLIC RECORD IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET ACT,
- 19 ACT NO. 431 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1984, BEING SECTIONS 18.1101 TO
- 20 18.1594 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.
- 21 (5) A DOCUMENT, REPORT, OR PUBLIC RECORD DESCRIBED IN THIS
- 22 SECTION IS SUBJECT TO THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT.
- 23 (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 24 (A) "DEPARTMENT DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION" INCLUDES THE
- 25 DIRECTOR OR CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF A DEPARTMENT IDENTIFIED IN
- 26 SUBSECTION (1), OR ANY COMMISSION, AGENCY, OR OTHER BODY
- 27 ESTABLISHED WITHIN THAT DEPARTMENT.

- (B) "FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT" MEANS ACT NO. 442 OF THE
- 2 PUBLIC ACTS OF 1976, BEING SECTIONS 15.231 TO 15.246 OF THE
- 3 MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.
- (C) "PERSON" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF THE
- 5 FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT, BEING SECTION 15.232 OF THE MICHIGAN
- 6 COMPILED LAWS, AND ADDITIONALLY INCLUDES THE GOVERNOR, THE EXECU-
- 7 TIVE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, THE EXECU-
- 8 TIVE OFFICE OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, AND THE EMPLOYEES AND
- 9 AGENTS OF EACH INDIVIDUAL OR OFFICE DESCRIBED IN THIS
- 10 SUBDIVISION.
- (D) "PUBLIC RECORD" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 11 12 OF THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT.
