September 10, 1996, Introduced by Senators YOUNG, CONROY, V. SMITH, CHERRY, STALLINGS, A. SMITH, HART, O'BRIEN, DE BEAUSSAERT, KOIVISTO, BYRUM, VAUGHN, DINGELL, BERRYMAN, MILLER and PETERS and referred to the Committee on Families, Mental Health and Human Services.

A bill to amend Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1939, entitled as amended

"The social welfare act,"

as amended, being sections 400.1 to 400.119b of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding sections 57j and 57k.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1939, as
- 2 amended, being sections 400.1 to 400.119b of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding sections 57j and 57k to read
- 4 as follows:
- 5 SEC. 57J. (!) A STATE PLAN REQUIRED BY THE FEDERAL GOVERN-
- 6 MENT AS A CONDITION OF THE RECEIPT OF FEDERAL BLOCK GRANT FUNDS
- 7 SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE LEGISLATURE NOT LESS THAN 60 DAYS
- 8 BEFORE THE FAMILY INDEPENDENCE AGENCY SUBMITS THE PLAN TO THE
- 9 FEDERAL AGENCY.

- 1 (2) THE FAMILY INDEPENDENCE AGENCY SHALL SUBMIT TO THE
- 2 LEGISLATURE A COPY OF EACH ANNUAL REPORT THAT IT MAKES TO A FED-
- 3 ERAL AGENCY DETAILING THE USE OF BLOCK GRANT FUNDS.
- 4 SEC. 57K. ALL TRANSFERS OF BLOCK GRANT FUNDS RECEIVED BY
- 5 THE FAMILY INDEPENDENCE AGENCY SHALL BE MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH
- 6 SECTION 393 OF THE MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET ACT, ACT NO. 431 OF THE
- 7 PUBLIC ACTS OF 1984, BEING SECTION 18.1393 OF THE MICHIGAN
