

## **SENATE BILL No. 1127**

September 10, 1996, Introduced by Senator YOUNG and referred to the Committee on Health Policy and Senior Citizens.

A bill to amend the title and sections 2, 4, 5, 14, and 16 of Act No. 70 of the Public Acts of 1961, entitled "Seal of quality act,"

being sections 289.632, 289.634, 289.635, 289.644, and 289.646 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. The title and sections 2, 4, 5, 14, and 16 of
- 2 Act No. 70 of the Public Acts of 1961, being sections 289.632,
- 3 289.634, 289.635, 289.644, and 289.646 of the Michigan Compiled
- 4 Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 5 TITLE
- 6 An act to promote the development and to encourage consump-
- 7 tion of Michigan agricultural AND SEAFOOD products by use of a
- 8 seal denoting quality; to prescribe the powers and duties of the
- 9 -state- department of agriculture; to establish procedures for

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- 1 ESTABLISHING standards; to provide for fees; to authorize the
- 2 appointment of -commodity CERTAIN committees; and to prescribe
- 3 penalties. -for violations.
- 4 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 5 (A) "AGRICULTURAL PRODUCT" MEANS AN AGRICULTURAL PRODUCT
- 6 GROWN, PACKED, AND PROCESSED WITHIN THIS STATE.
- 7 (B)  $\frac{1}{2}$  "Commission" means the commission of agriculture.
- 8 (C) -(b) "Department" means the -state department of
- 9 agriculture.
- 10 (D) (c) "Director" means the state director of THE
- 11 DEPARTMENT OF agriculture.
- 12 (E) -(d) "Person" means -individuals, partnerships, trusts,
- 13 associations, corporations, and any and all other business units,
- 14 devices and arrangements, or receiver, trustee or assignee of
- 15 such business units AN INDIVIDUAL, PARTNERSHIP, CORPORATION,
- 16 ASSOCIATION, OR OTHER LEGAL ENTITY.
- (F) (e) "Michigan seal of quality" means <del>any</del> A label,
- 18 tag, or other device bearing the official emblem promulgated
- 19 under the provisions of this act containing the term "Michigan
- 20 seal of quality" attached to, affixed, or placed upon any crate,
- 21 carton, package, or other container of agricultural products
- 22 grown, packed and processed within this state OR SEAFOOD
- 23 PRODUCTS.
- 24 (f) "Products" mean agricultural products grown, packed and
- 25 processed within this state.

- 1 (G) "SEAFOOD PRODUCT" MEANS FISH OR OTHER SEAFOOD FOUND IN
- 2 LAKE MICHIGAN, LAKE HURON, LAKE SUPERIOR, OR LAKE ERIE OR A
- 3 CONNECTING WATERWAY.
- 4 Sec. 4. Upon the request of any A commodity group of pro-
- 5 ducers of AN agricultural -products stating PRODUCT OR GROUP OF
- 6 PRODUCERS OF A SEAFOOD PRODUCT that BELIEVES it is essential to
- 7 the successful marketing of the -products- PRODUCT that standards
- 8 of quality be established FOR THAT PRODUCT, the commission, after
- 9 not less than 10 days' notice, shall call a public hearing at
- 10 which any interested person -shall have HAS the right to be
- 11 heard , and thereafter ON THE MATTER. AFTER RECEIVING
- 12 TESTIMONY, the commission shall determine whether the establish-
- 13 ment of standards of quality for the products AGRICULTURAL OR
- 14 SEAFOOD PRODUCT is necessary to the successful marketing
- 15 thereof OF THE PRODUCT.
- 16 Sec. 5. The commission, if IF it determines that it is
- 17 necessary to establish standards of quality for <del>any products</del> AN
- 18 AGRICULTURAL OR SEAFOOD PRODUCT, THE COMMISSION shall promulgate
- 19 an order establishing standards of quality for the products,
- 20 which PRODUCT. THE standards shall -relate INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE
- 21 LIMITED to, the quality, size, and condition -thereof- OF THE
- 22 PRODUCT, AS APPROPRIATE.
- Sec. 14. The commission shall enforce this act and may
- 24 promulgate such orders, rules and regulations in accordance with
- 25 Act No. 88 of the Public Acts of 1943, as amended, being sections
- 26 24.71 to 24.82 of the Compiled Laws of 1948, and subject to Act
- 27 No. 197 of the Public Acts of 1952, as amended, being sections

- 1 24.101 to 24.110 of the Compiled Laws of 1948, as are necessary
- 2 to carry out the purposes of this act RULES NECESSARY TO IMPLE-
- 3 MENT THIS ACT UNDER THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT OF 1969,
- 4 ACT NO. 306 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1969, BEING SECTIONS 24.201 TO
- 5 24.328 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS. When IF the director -
- 6 or any OR A person appointed by him, THE DIRECTOR determines
- 7 that -products AN AGRICULTURAL OR SEAFOOD PRODUCT bearing the
- 8 seal -fail FAILS to conform to the quality characteristics and
- 9 standards promulgated by the commission, the director or -his-
- 10 THE DIRECTOR'S appointee may seize and dispose of the products as
- 11 provided by section 7 of Act No. 211 of the Public Acts of 1893,
- 12 as amended, being section 289.37 of the MICHIGAN Compiled Laws.
- 13 <del>of 1948.</del>
- 14 Sec. 16. The commission, after adopting rules to implement
- 15 this act, shall establish commodity AND SEAFOOD committees to
- 16 disseminate information relative to the purposes of this act and
- 17 to report to the commission -in reference to the functioning
- 18 thereof CONCERNING THE COMMITTEE'S WORK. Commodity AND SEAFOOD
- 19 committees shall consist of representatives of producers, first
- 20 handlers, wholesalers, retailers, and consumers capable of being
- 21 recognized as representative of the specific commodity OR SEAFOOD
- 22 interests involved by that industry. The commission may estab-
- 23 lish committees for any specific commodity OR SEAFOOD when
- 24 requested to do so by any A representative segment of that
- 25 -commodity industry. The commission shall create a central com-
- 26 mittee representative of all commodity AND SEAFOOD committees and
- 27 of -such- other governmental agencies -as may THAT have

- 1 interests in furthering the purposes of this act upon the
- 2 request of 3 existing -commodity- committees. The members of all
- 3 committees shall be that number determined and approved by the
- 4 commission. The members of committees shall hold office for a
- 5 period of 1 year. The commission may reappoint -any A member of
- 6 -any A committee. The per diem compensation of committee mem-
- 7 bers and the schedule for reimbursement of expenses shall be
- 8 established annually by the legislature.
