

SENATE BILL No. 1138

September 12, 1996, Introduced by Senators NORTH, HART, KOIVISTO, MC MANUS and BULLARD and referred to the Committee on Local, Urban and State Affairs.

A bill to designate the use of certain gaming revenues.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. Each tribal-state gaming compact negotiated pursu-2 ant to section 11 of the Indian gaming regulatory act, Public Law 3 100-497, 25 U.S.C. 2710, after January 1, 1997, shall include a 4 provision that 8% of the revenue from class III gaming as defined 5 in section 4 of the Indian gaming regulatory act, Public Law 6 100-497, 25 U.S.C. 2703, shall be deposited in the cleanup and 7 redevelopment fund created in section 20108 of part 201 8 (environmental remediation) of the natural resources and environ-9 mental protection act, Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, 10 being section 324.20108 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
