- 2 WHO KNOWINGLY VIOLATES SECTION 61503A OR 61503B IS RESPONSIBLE
- 3 FOR THE PAYMENT OF A CIVIL FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$25,000.00. A
- 4 DEFAULT IN THE PAYMENT OF A CIVIL FINE OR COSTS ORDERED UNDER
- 5 THIS SECTION OR AN INSTALLMENT OF THE FINE OR COSTS MAY BE REME-
- 6 DIED BY ANY MEANS AUTHORIZED UNDER THE REVISED JUDICATURE ACT OF

- 8 (2) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OR OTHER PERSON MAY BRING AN ACTION
- 9 IN CIRCUIT COURT FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF OR DAMAGES, OR BOTH,
- 10 AGAINST A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SECTION 61503A OR 61503B.

  [(3) IF A PERSON WHO HAS ENTERED INTO A GAS LEASE AS A LESSEE VIOLATES SECTION 61503A OR 61503B, EACH DAY THE VIOLATION CONTINUES CONSTITUTES A SEPARATE OFFENSE ONLY FOR 5 DAYS; THEREAFTER, EACH DAY THE VIOLATION CONTINUES DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A SEPARATE OFFENSE.
