- 5 (A) THE PROPERTY IN DISPUTE WAS ONCE OWNED BY A MICHIGAN
- 6 INDIAN TRIBE.
- 7 (B) A MICHIGAN INDIAN TRIBE CLAIMS OWNERSHIP OF THE
- 8 PROPERTY.
- 9 (C) AT THE TIME OF THE DISPUTE, THE PROPERTY IS OWNED BY 1
- 10 OR MORE RESIDENTS OF THIS STATE.
