A bill to amend 1964 PA 154, entitled
"Minimum wage law of 1964,"
by amending section 14 (MCL 408.394).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

3 fruit growers, pickle growers and tomato growers, or other agri-
4 cultural employers who traditionally contract for ~~the~~ harvest-
5 ing on a piecework basis, as to those employees of such employers
6 used for such harvesting until the board shall have acquired suf-
7 ficient data to determine an adequate basis for the establishment
8 of a scale of piecework and shall determine such a scale equiva-
9 lent to the prevailing minimum wage for such employment, which
10 determination shall occur no later than May 1, 1967. Such piece
11 rate scale shall be equivalent to the minimum hourly wage in that
12 when the payment by unit of production is applied to a worker of
13 average ability and diligence in harvesting a particular commod-
14 ity he OR SHE shall receive an amount not less than the hourly
15 minimum wage.
