THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 6. (1) A person is eligible to become a corpsmember if
 he or she:

3 (a) Is a resident of this state.

4 (b) Except for supervisors, is not less than 18 years of age5 and not more than 25 years of age on the date of application.

6 (c) Is not employed at the time of hire.

7 (d) Is not a son or daughter of an elected or appointed
8 official of this state or of a city, village, county, township,
9 school district, intermediate school district, or other
10 governmental authority.

(e) If employed as a supervisor, was not on the department's
 or recipient's payroll within 30 days before being hired through
 a program established with funds received under this act unless
 he or she was promoted from a general corpsmember to a corps
 supervisor.

6 (2) If the number of persons applying for positions in a
7 work training program established under this act exceeds the
8 number of positions created, the chief shall give priority in
9 hiring to recipients of general assistance and aid to families
10 with dependent children. In hiring supervisors, the chief also
11 shall give priority to qualified recipients of general assistance
12 and aid to families with dependent children.

13 (3) The chief shall ensure that eligible minority persons, 14 eligible persons who are members of households the heads of which 15 are single, eligible persons who are handicapped WITH 16 DISABILITIES, and equal numbers of eligible males and females, to 17 the extent that these persons apply for the program, are hired as 18 corpsmembers.

(4) The chief shall notify the director of the department of social services of any work training program established under this act. The director of the department of social services shall take any action necessary to notify all employable recipients of general assistance and aid to families with dependent children who are eligible under this act, who are not currently sasigned to employment, training, or an educational program, of the work training programs established under this act.
