- 4 COUNTIES. THE MEMBERSHIP OF A CHILD FATALITY REVIEW TEAM SHALL
- 5 CONSIST OF AT LEAST ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 6 (A) A COUNTY MEDICAL EXAMINER OR DEPUTY COUNTY MEDICAL
- 7 EXAMINER APPOINTED UNDER 1963 PA 181, MCL 52.201 TO 52.216.
