- 7 OFFICER TO COMMIT OR ATTEMPT TO COMMIT A CRIME.
- 8 (2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (3) AND (4), AN INDI-
- 9 VIDUAL WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND SHALL
- 10 BE PUNISHED BY IMPRISONMENT FOR 2 YEARS.

- 16 (7) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "PEACE OFFICER" MEANS 1 OR MORE
- 17 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 18 (A) A POLICE OFFICER OF THIS STATE OR ANOTHER STATE OR A
- 19 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE OR ANOTHER STATE.
- 20 (B) A FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.
- 21 (C) THE SHERIFF OF A COUNTY OF THIS STATE OR ANOTHER STATE
- 22 OR THE SHERIFF'S DEPUTY.
- 23 (D) A POLICE OR PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER OF A COMMUNITY COL-
- 24 LEGE, COLLEGE, OR UNIVERSITY WHO IS AUTHORIZED BY THE GOVERNING
- 25 BOARD OF THAT COMMUNITY COLLEGE, COLLEGE, OR UNIVERSITY TO
- 26 ENFORCE STATE LAW AND THE RULES AND ORDINANCES OF THAT COMMUNITY
- 27 COLLEGE, COLLEGE, OR UNIVERSITY.
