SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 785

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 145e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 145E. (1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SECTION 145D IS GUILTY
- 2 OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE AS FOLLOWS:
- 3 (A) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 2
- 4 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$2,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 5 (B) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, BY IMPRISONMENT FOR
- 6 NOT MORE THAN 5 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.00, OR
- **7** BOTH.
- 8 (2) THIS SECTION AND SECTION 145D DO NOT PROHIBIT A PERSON
- 9 FROM BEING CHARGED WITH, CONVICTED OF, OR PUNISHED FOR ANY OTHER
- 10 VIOLATION OF LAW COMMITTED BY THAT PERSON WHILE VIOLATING SECTION
- 11 145D, INCLUDING THE UNDERLYING OFFENSE.
