## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 316. (1) The commission shall require each provider of
 residential basic local exchange service to offer certain low
 income customers the availability of basic local exchange service
 AND ACCESS SERVICE at a rate below the regulated rate REDUCED
 RATES AS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTIONS (2) AND (3).

(3) The basic local exchange rate for IF THE low income 6 7 - customers - CUSTOMER IS 65 years of age or more, THE RATE  $8~{\rm REDUCTION}$  shall be -25% or \$4.00- AT A MINIMUM, 25\% OF THE BASIC 9 LOCAL EXCHANGE RATE OR \$8.25, which shall be inclusive of any 10 federal contribution, whichever is greater. -, below the requ-11 lated rate.

(4) THE TOTAL REDUCTION UNDER SUBSECTION (2) OR (3) SHALL 12 13 NOT EXCEED 100% OF ALL END-USER COMMON LINE CHARGES AND THE BASIC 14 LOCAL EXCHANGE RATE.

(5) TO QUALIFY FOR THE REDUCED RATE UNDER THIS SECTION, THE 15 16 PERSON'S ANNUAL INCOME SHALL NOT EXCEED 150% OF THE FEDERAL POV-17 ERTY INCOME STANDARDS AS DETERMINED BY THE UNITED STATES OFFICE 18 OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET AND AS APPROVED BY THE STATE TREASURER. (6) -(4) The commission shall establish a rate for each 19 20 subscriber line of a provider to allow the provider to recover 21 costs incurred under this section.

(7) - (5) The commission shall take necessary action to 22 23 notify the general public of the availability of lifeline serv-24 ices including, but not limited to, public service announcements, 25 newspaper notices, and such other notice reasonably calculated to 26 reach those who may benefit from the services.
