THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Senate Bill No. 825 as amended December 10, 1998 2 1 CHAPTER IX 2 Sec. 34. (1) The sentencing guidelines promulgated by order 3 of the Michigan supreme court AND RESCINDED BY SUPREME COURT 4 ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 1998-2 SHALL CONTINUE TO APPLY TO FELONIES 5 COVERED BY THOSE GUIDELINES AND COMMITTED BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1999 6 AND shall not apply to felonies enumerated in part 2 of 7 chapter XVII committed on or after January 1, 1999. 9 (2) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection or for a 10 departure from the appropriate minimum sentence range provided 11 for under subsection (3), the minimum sentence imposed by a court 12 of this state for a felony enumerated in part 2 of chapter XVII 13 committed on or after January 1, 1999 shall 14 be within the appropriate sentence range under the version of 15 those sentencing guidelines in effect on the date the crime was 16 committed. Both of the following apply to minimum sentences 17 under this subsection: 18 (a) If a statute mandates a minimum sentence, the court 19 shall impose sentence in accordance with that statute. Imposing 20 a mandatory minimum sentence OR A SENTENCE THAT EXCEEDS THE REC-21 OMMENDED SENTENCE RANGE BUT IS LESS THAN THE MANDATORY MINIMUM 22 SENTENCE is not a departure under this section. 23 (b) The court shall not impose a minimum sentence, including

24 a departure, that exceeds 2/3 of the statutory maximum sentence.

25 (3) A court may depart from the appropriate sentence range 26 established under the sentencing guidelines set forth in chapter

27 XVII if the court has a substantial and compelling reason for

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- 1 that departure and states on the record the reasons for
- 2 departure. All of the following apply to a departure:
- 3 (a) The court shall not use an individual's gender, race,
- 4 ethnicity, alienage, national origin, legal occupation, lack of
- 5 employment, representation by appointed legal counsel, represen-
- 6 tation by retained legal counsel, appearance in propria persona,
- 7 or religion to depart from the appropriate sentence range.
- 8 (b) The court shall not base a departure on an offense char-
- 9 acteristic or offender characteristic already taken into account
- 10 in determining the appropriate sentence range unless the court
- 11 finds from the facts contained in the court record, including the
- 12 presentence investigation report, that the characteristic has
- 13 been given inadequate or disproportionate weight.
- 14 (4) Intermediate sanctions shall be imposed under this chap-
- 15 ter as follows:
- 16 (a) If the upper limit of the recommended minimum sentence
- 17 range for a defendant determined under the sentencing guidelines
- 18 set forth in chapter XVII is 18 months or less, the court shall
- 19 impose an intermediate sanction unless the court states on the
- 20 record a substantial and compelling reason to sentence the indi-
- 21 vidual to the jurisdiction of the department of corrections. An
- 22 intermediate sanction may include a jail term that does not
- 23 exceed the upper limit of the recommended minimum sentence range
- 24 or 12 months, whichever is less.
- 25 (b) If the offense is a violation of section 7401(2)(a)(iv)
- 26 or 7403(2)(a)(iv) of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL
- 27 333.7401 and 333.7403, and the upper limit of the recommended

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- 1 minimum sentence range is 18 months or less, the court shall
- 2 impose a sentence of life probation absent a departure.
- 3 (c) If an attempt to commit a felony designated in offense
- 4 class H in part 2 of this chapter is punishable by imprisonment
- 5 for more than 1 year, the court shall impose an intermediate
- 6 sanction upon conviction of that offense absent a departure.
- 7 (d) If the upper limit of the recommended minimum sentence
- 8 exceeds 18 months and the lower limit of the recommended minimum
- 9 sentence is 12 months or less, the court shall sentence the
- 10 offender as follows absent a departure:
- 11 (i) To imprisonment with a minimum term within that range.
- 12 (ii) To an intermediate sanction that may include a term of
- 13 imprisonment of not [less than the minimum range or] more than 12
- 14 months.
- 15 (5) If a crime has a mandatory determinant penalty or a man-
- 16 datory penalty of life imprisonment, the court shall impose that
- 17 penalty. This section does not apply to sentencing for that
- 18 crime.
- 19 (6) As part of the sentence, the court may also order the
- 20 defendant to pay any combination of a fine, costs, or applicable
- 21 assessments. The court shall order payment of restitution as
- 22 provided by law.
- 23 (7) If the trial court imposes on a defendant a minimum sen-
- 24 tence that is longer or more severe than the appropriate sentence
- 25 range, as part of the court's advice of the defendant's rights
- 26 concerning appeal, the court shall advise the defendant orally
- 27 and in writing that he or she may appeal the sentence as provided

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- 1 by law on grounds that it is longer or more severe than the
- 2 appropriate sentence range.
- 3 (8) All of the following shall be part of the record filed
- 4 for an appeal of a sentence under this section:
- 5 (a) An entire record of the sentencing proceedings.
- 6 (b) The presentence investigation report. Any portion of
- 7 the presentence investigation report exempt from disclosure by
- 8 law shall not be a public record.
- 9 (c) Any other reports or documents the sentencing court used
- 10 in imposing sentence.
- 11 (9) An appeal of a sentence under this section does not stay
- 12 execution of the sentence.
- 13 (10) If a minimum sentence is within the appropriate guide-
- 14 lines sentence range, the court of appeals shall affirm that sen-
- 15 tence and shall not remand for resentencing absent an error in
- 16 scoring the sentencing guidelines or inaccurate information
- 17 relied upon in determining the defendant's sentence. A party
- 18 shall not raise on appeal an issue challenging the scoring of the
- 19 sentencing guidelines or challenging the accuracy of information
- 20 relied upon in determining a sentence that is within the appro-
- 21 priate guidelines sentence range unless the party has raised the
- 22 issue at sentencing, in a proper motion for resentencing, or in a
- 23 proper motion to remand filed in the court of appeals.
- 24 (11) If, upon a review of the record, the court of appeals
- 25 finds the trial court did not have a substantial and compelling
- 26 reason for departing from the appropriate sentence range, the

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- 1 court shall remand the matter to the sentencing judge or another
- 2 trial court judge for resentencing under this chapter.
- 3 (12) Time served on the sentence appealed under this section
- 4 is considered time served on any sentence imposed after remand.
