A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 504a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 504A. (1) AT A DESIGNATED SHOOTING RANGE ON LAND UNDER
- 2 THE CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENT, AN INDIVIDUAL MAY USE A FIREARM
- 3 LOADED WITH ANY NUMBER OF ROUNDS NOT EXCEEDING THE MANUFACTURER'S
- 4 ORIGINAL MAGAZINE CAPACITY AND MAY DISCHARGE WITHOUT INTERRUPTION
- 5 ANY OR ALL OF THE ROUNDS IN THE FIREARM. HOWEVER, FOR A RECOG-
- 6 NIZED SHOOTING COMPETITION, AN INDIVIDUAL MAY USE A FIREARM
- 7 LOADED WITH ANY NUMBER OF ROUNDS NOT EXCEEDING THE NUMBER AUTHO-
- 8 RIZED UNDER THE RULES OF THE COMPETITION.
- 9 (2) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (1), AT A DESIGNATED SHOOTING
- 10 RANGE ON LAND UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENT, AN INDIVIDUAL
