January 8, 1997, Introduced by Rep. Fitzgerald and referred to the Committee on Corrections.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code," (MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 479c.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 479C. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT DO EITHER OF THE
- 2 FOLLOWING:
- 3 (A) ASSAULT OR BATTER A CORRECTIONS OFFICER WHILE KNOWING OR
- 4 HAVING REASON TO KNOW THE CORRECTIONS OFFICER IS LAWFULLY PER-
- 5 FORMING HIS OR HER DUTIES AS A CORRECTIONS OFFICER.
- 6 (B) OBSTRUCT, RESIST, OR OPPOSE A CORRECTIONS OFFICER WHILE
- 7 KNOWING OR HAVING REASON TO KNOW THE CORRECTIONS OFFICER IS LAW-
- 8 FULLY PERFORMING HIS OR HER DUTIES AS A CORRECTIONS OFFICER.
- 9 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
- 10 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 2 YEARS
- 11 OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.

- 8 CONSECUTIVELY TO THAT TERM OF IMPRISONMENT.
- 9 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "CORRECTIONS OFFICER" MEANS A
- 10 PRISON OR JAIL SECURITY OFFICER OR OTHER EMPLOYEE OF A JAIL OR A
- 11 STATE OR FEDERAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY WHO PERFORMS DUTIES
- 12 INVOLVING THE TRANSPORTATION, CARE, CUSTODY, OR SUPERVISION OF
- **13** PRISONERS.
