THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 20141. (1) A person shall not establish or maintain
 and operate a health facility or agency without holding a license
 from ISSUED BY the department.

(1) The department, after obtaining approval of 24 the advisory commission, shall promulgate and enforce rules to 25 implement this article, including, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, rules nec-26 essary to enable a health facility or agency to qualify for and 27 receive federal funds available for patient care or for projects

construction, functional design, sanitation, maintenance,
housekeeping, and fire safety.

5 (4) The rules promulgated under section 21563 for the desig6 nation of rural community hospitals may also specify all of the
7 following:

8 (a) Maximum bed size.

9 (b) The level of services to be provided in each category as10 described in section 21562(2).

11 (c) Requirements for transfer agreements with other hospi-12 tals to assure efficient and appropriate patient care.
