SEC. 29A. (1) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL REPRESENT A RESI DENT OF THIS STATE IN A CIVIL ACTION IF THE ACTION INVOLVES A
DISPUTE OVER THE OWNERSHIP OF PROPERTY WHEN ALL OF THE FOLLOWING
CIRCUMSTANCES EXIST:

5 (A) THE PROPERTY IN DISPUTE WAS ONCE OWNED BY A MICHIGAN6 INDIAN TRIBE.

7 (B) A MICHIGAN INDIAN TRIBE CLAIMS OWNERSHIP OF THE8 PROPERTY.

9 (C) AT THE TIME OF THE DISPUTE, THE PROPERTY IS OWNED BY 110 OR MORE RESIDENTS OF THIS STATE.

4 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "MICHIGAN INDIAN TRIBE" MEANS A 5 FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED INDIAN TRIBE THAT HAS TRUST LANDS LOCATED 6 WITHIN THIS STATE.
