HOUSE BILL No. 5451

January 14, 1998, Introduced by Reps. Law, Palamara and Varga and referred to the Committee on Insurance.

A bill to amend 1980 PA 350, entitled "The nonprofit health care corporation reform act," (MCL 550.1101 to 550.1704) by adding section 415a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 415A. (1) A HEALTH CARE CORPORATION SHALL PROVIDE IN
- 2 EACH GROUP AND NONGROUP CERTIFICATE BENEFITS FOR SCALP HAIR PROS-
- 3 THESIS FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS SCALP HAIR LOSS AS A RESULT OF
- 4 ALOPECIA AREATA IF THE INDIVIDUAL'S ATTENDING PHYSICIAN CERTIFIES
- 5 IN WRITING THE MEDICAL NECESSITY OF THAT PROPOSED COURSE OF REHA-
- 6 BILITATIVE TREATMENT.
- 7 (2) THE COVERAGE REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION IS NOT SUBJECT TO
- 8 DOLLAR LIMITS, DEDUCTIBLES, AND COINSURANCE PROVISIONS THAT ARE
- 9 LESS FAVORABLE THAN THOSE FOR OTHER PROSTHESIS COVERAGE.
- 10 HOWEVER, A HEALTH CARE CORPORATION MAY PROVIDE THAT THE HEALTH

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- 1 CARE CORPORATION WILL ONLY PAY 80% OF THE CUSTOMARY AND USUAL
- 2 COSTS OF THE SCALP HAIR PROSTHESIS EXCLUSIVE OF ANY DEDUCTIBLE.
- 3 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "SCALP HAIR PROSTHESIS"
- 4 INCLUDES ANY ARTIFICIAL SUBSTITUTES FOR SCALP HAIR.

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
