THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

SEC. 74105A. (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH AN
 "ADOPT-A-TRAIL" PROGRAM THAT WILL ALLOW VOLUNTEER GROUPS TO
 ASSIST IN MAINTAINING AND ENHANCING MICHIGAN TRAILWAYS.

4 (2) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (3), VOLUNTEER GROUPS IN THE
5 ADOPT-A-TRAIL PROGRAM MAY ADOPT ANY AVAILABLE MICHIGAN TRAILWAY
6 OR MICHIGAN TRAILWAY SEGMENT AND MAY CHOOSE ANY 1 OR MORE OF THE
7 FOLLOWING VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES:

- **8** (A) SPRING CLEANUPS.
- **9** (B) ENVIRONMENTAL ACTIVITIES.

10 (C) ACCESSIBILITY PROJECTS.

5 (3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DESIGNATE THE ACTIVITIES TO BE PER6 FORMED BY A VOLUNTEER GROUP IN THE ADOPT-A-TRAIL PROGRAM. THE
7 DEPARTMENT MAY PROVIDE FOR MORE THAN 1 VOLUNTEER GROUP TO ADOPT A

10 ADOPT-A-TRAIL PROGRAM SHALL SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE DEPART11 MENT ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT. ADDITIONALLY, VOLUN12 TEER GROUPS SHALL AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING:

13 (A) VOLUNTEER GROUPS SHALL PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM FOR AT14 LEAST A 2-YEAR PERIOD.

15 (B) VOLUNTEER GROUPS SHALL CONSIST OF AT LEAST 6 PEOPLE WHO
16 ARE 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER, UNLESS THE VOLUNTEER GROUP IS A
17 SCHOOL OR SCOUT ORGANIZATION, IN WHICH CASE THE VOLUNTEERS MAY BE
18 UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE.

19 (C) VOLUNTEER GROUPS SHALL CONTRIBUTE A TOTAL OF AT LEAST20 400 SERVICE HOURS OVER A 2-YEAR PERIOD.

21 (D) VOLUNTEER GROUPS SHALL COMPLY WITH OTHER REASONABLE22 REQUIREMENTS OF THE DEPARTMENT.

23 (5) A STATE PARK MANAGER MAY ISSUE TO VOLUNTEERS WHO ARE
24 ACTIVELY WORKING ON ADOPT-A-TRAIL PROJECTS THAT LAST MORE THAN 1
25 DAY FREE CAMPING PERMITS IF CAMPSITES ARE AVAILABLE. A STATE
26 PARK MANAGER MAY WAIVE STATE PARK ENTRY FEES FOR VOLUNTEERS
27 ENTERING STATE PARKS TO WORK ON ADOPT-A-TRAIL PROJECTS.
