SENATE BILL NO. 868

February 10, 1998, Introduced by Senators BERRYMAN and SCHWARZ and referred to the Committee on Health Policy and Senior Citizens.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," by amending sections 17766c and 17770 (MCL 333.17766c and 333.17770), section 17766c as added by 1994 PA 38, and by adding section 17766d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 17766c. (1) A person shall not possess more than -10 2 grams of ephedrine, A SALT OF EPHEDRINE, AN OPTICAL ISOMER OF
 3 EPHEDRINE, OR A SALT OF AN OPTICAL ISOMER OF EPHEDRINE, alone OR
 4 IN COMBINATION, or -in- a SUBSTANCE OR mixture CONTAINING EPHED 5 RINE, A SALT OF EPHEDRINE, AN OPTICAL ISOMER OF EPHEDRINE, OR A
 6 SALT OF AN OPTICAL ISOMER OF EPHEDRINE.

7 (2) A person who violates this section is guilty of a felony
8 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 2 years or a fine of
9 not more than \$2,000.00, or both.

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(3) This section does not apply to any of the following:
 (a) A person who possesses ephedrine pursuant to a license
 issued IS LICENSED, REGISTERED, OR OTHERWISE PERMITTED by this
 state or the United States to manufacture, deliver DISTRIBUTE,
 PRESCRIBE, dispense, possess with intent to manufacture or
 deliver, or possess ADMINISTER, OR CONDUCT RESEARCH WITH a con trolled substance, prescription drug, or other drug AND WHO POS SESSES EPHEDRINE, A SALT OF EPHEDRINE, AN OPTICAL ISOMER OF
 EPHEDRINE, OR A SALT OF AN OPTICAL ISOMER OF EPHEDRINE IN CONNEC TION WITH THAT LICENSE, REGISTRATION, OR PERMISSION.

(b) An individual who possesses ephedrine, A SALT OF EPHED12 RINE, AN OPTICAL ISOMER OF EPHEDRINE, OR A SALT OF AN OPTICAL
13 ISOMER OF EPHEDRINE pursuant to a prescription OR A RETAIL SALE
14 PERMITTED UNDER SECTION 17766D.

(c) A person who possesses ephedrine, A SALT OF EPHEDRINE, AN OPTICAL ISOMER OF EPHEDRINE, OR A SALT OF AN OPTICAL ISOMER OF PHEDRINE for retail sale pursuant to a license issued pursuant to AT RETAIL SUBJECT TO THE TAX LEVIED UNDER the general sales tax act, Act No. 167 of the Public Acts of 1933, being sections 205.51 to 205.78 of the Michigan Compiled Laws 1933 PA 167, MCL 205.51 TO 205.78, THAT IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 21 17766D.

(d) A person who possesses ephedrine, A SALT OF EPHEDRINE,
AN OPTICAL ISOMER OF EPHEDRINE, OR A SALT OF AN OPTICAL ISOMER OF
EPHEDRINE in the course of his or her business of selling or
transporting ephedrine, A SALT OF EPHEDRINE, AN OPTICAL ISOMER OF

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PHEDRINE, OR A SALT OF AN OPTICAL ISOMER OF EPHEDRINE to a
 person described in subdivision (a) or (c).

3 (e) A person who , in the course of his or her business,
4 stores ephedrine, A SALT OF EPHEDRINE, AN OPTICAL ISOMER OF
5 EPHEDRINE, OR A SALT OF AN OPTICAL ISOMER OF EPHEDRINE IN THE
6 COURSE OF HIS OR HER BUSINESS for sale or distribution to a
7 person described in subdivision (a), (c), or (d).

8 SEC. 17766D. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT DELIVER A PRODUCT THAT
9 CONTAINS EPHEDRINE, A SALT OF EPHEDRINE, AN OPTICAL ISOMER OF
10 EPHEDRINE, OR A SALT OF AN OPTICAL ISOMER OF EPHEDRINE EXCEPT
11 PURSUANT TO A PRESCRIPTION OR AS A DISPENSING PRESCRIBER OR VET12 ERINARIAN ACTING IN THE SCOPE OF THAT PERSON'S PRACTICE.

13 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS GUILTY OF A MIS14 DEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR A
15 FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.

16 (3) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT APPLY TO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
17 (A) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (5), THE SALE BY A MANUFACTURER,
18 WHOLESALE DISTRIBUTOR, OR RETAILER OF A PRODUCT DESCRIBED IN SUB19 SECTION (1) IF THE PRODUCT MAY BE LAWFULLY SOLD OVER THE COUNTER
20 WITHOUT A PRESCRIPTION UNDER THE FEDERAL ACT AND IF THE BOARD
21 DETERMINES AFTER NOTICE AND A HEARING THAT THE PRODUCT IS BOTH OF
22 THE FOLLOWING:

23 (*i*) LABELED AND MARKETED IN A MANNER CONSISTENT WITH THE
24 APPLICABLE FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION RULES AND GUIDELINES CON25 CERNING OVER-THE-COUNTER PRODUCTS.

26 (*ii*) MANUFACTURED AND DISTRIBUTED FOR LEGITIMATE MEDICAL USE27 IN A MANNER THAT REDUCES OR ELIMINATES THE LIKELIHOOD OF ABUSE.

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(B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (4), THE SALE BY A
 MANUFACTURER, WHOLESALE DISTRIBUTOR, OR RETAILER OF 1 OR MORE OF
 THE FOLLOWING PRODUCTS:

5 (*ii*) BRONCARE.

- 6 (*iii*) BRONCHIAL CONGESTION.
- 7 (*iv*) BRONKAID TABLETS.

- **15** (*xii*) QUELIDRINE.

16 (xiii) RESP.

17 (xiv) VATRONAL NOSE DROPS.

18 (C) THE DELIVERY OF A PRODUCT DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) TO
19 A PERSON LICENSED, REGISTERED, OR OTHERWISE PERMITTED BY THIS
20 STATE OR THE UNITED STATES TO MANUFACTURE, DISTRIBUTE, PRESCRIBE,
21 DISPENSE, ADMINISTER, OR CONDUCT RESEARCH WITH A CONTROLLED SUB22 STANCE, PRESCRIPTION DRUG, OR OTHER DRUG, IN CONNECTION WITH THAT
23 LICENSE, REGISTRATION, OR PERMISSION.

24 (4) THE BOARD MAY REMOVE THE EXEMPTION OF A PRODUCT EXEMPTED
25 OR LISTED IN SUBSECTION (3) IF THE BOARD DETERMINES AFTER NOTICE
26 AND A HEARING THAT THE PRODUCT DOES NOT MEET THE CRITERIA OF
27 SUBSECTION (3)(A)(i) AND (ii).

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(5) IN DETERMINING WHETHER TO EXEMPT A PRODUCT UNDER
 SUBSECTION (3), THE BOARD SHALL CONSIDER ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
 (A) THE MANNER OF PACKAGING THE PRODUCT, INCLUDING THE PACK-

4 AGE SIZE.

5 (B) THE PRODUCT'S NAME AND LABELING.

6 (C) THE MANNER OF DISTRIBUTING, ADVERTISING, AND PROMOTING7 THE PRODUCT.

8 (D) THE DURATION, SCOPE, AND SIGNIFICANCE OF ABUSE OF THE9 PRODUCT.

10 (E) THE NEED TO PROVIDE MEDICALLY IMPORTANT THERAPIES CON11 TAINING EPHEDRINE, ITS SALTS OR OPTICAL ISOMERS, OR SALTS OF ITS
12 OPTICAL ISOMERS TO THE PUBLIC ON AN OVER-THE-COUNTER BASIS FOR
13 INDICATIONS APPROVED BY THE FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION.

14 (F) OTHER FACTS OR CONSIDERATIONS THE BOARD DETERMINES ARE15 RELEVANT TO AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY.

16 (6) NOT LESS THAN ONCE A YEAR, THE BOARD SHALL PUBLISH A
17 LIST OF PRODUCTS EXEMPTED UNDER SUBSECTION (3)(A) OR FOR WHICH
18 THE BOARD HAS REMOVED AN EXEMPTION UNDER SUBSECTION (4).

19 (7) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

20 (A) "DELIVER" OR "DELIVERY" MEANS THE ACTUAL OR CONSTRUCTIVE
21 TRANSFER OR ATTEMPTED TRANSFER OF A PRODUCT DESCRIBED IN SUBSEC22 TION (1) FROM 1 PERSON TO ANOTHER, WHETHER OR NOT THERE IS AN
23 AGENCY RELATIONSHIP.

(B) "RETAILER" MEANS A PERSON WHO MAKES SALES AT RETAIL
SUBJECT TO THE TAX LEVIED UNDER THE GENERAL SALES TAX ACT, 1933
PA 167, MCL 205.51 TO 205.78.

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Sec. 17770. Except as to the labeling of poisonous or
 deleterious drugs and to adulterating, misbranding, and
 substituting, this part shall DOES not apply TO ANY OF THE
 FOLLOWING:

5 (a) To the THE sale of paris green, white hellebore, and
6 OR other insecticides.

7 (b) To the THE sale of any substance for use in the arts.
8 (c) To the EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 17766D, THE
9 retailing of non-narcotic, A NONNARCOTIC or nonprescription
10 medicine or drug which THAT is prepackaged, fully prepared by
11 the manufacturer or producer for use by the consumer, and labeled
12 in accordance with the requirements of the state THIS ACT and
13 THE federal act.

14 (d) To the THE sale by merchants of ammonia, sulphur, 15 any nonpoisonous flavoring essences or extracts, salt, bicar-16 bonate of soda, or other prepackaged common household remedies or 17 any food or food product which THAT may also be found in any 18 of the official compendiums and is not also considered as a 19 poisonous, deleterious, or habit forming drug.

(e) To surgical SURGICAL or dental instruments and accessories, hearing aids, gases, oxygen tents, gas pressure reducing regulators, x-ray apparatus, therapeutic lamps, splints, and OR stethoscopes —, and their component parts and accessories OF THOSE ITEMS, or to equipment, instruments, apparatus, and contrivances used to render the articles effective in medical, surgical, or dental treatment, —, or to articles intended for external use.

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(f) To articles ARTICLES or substances intended for
 generally recognized mechanical, agricultural, horticultural, or
 industrial consumption or use or photographic chemicals for home
 use.

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
