- 1 SEC. 571. UNLESS FEDERAL LAW OR OTHER STATE LAW REQUIRES
- 2 OTHERWISE, A PERSON WHO IS AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE BUT NOT OLDER
- 3 THAN 50 YEARS OF AGE, AND WHO IS NOT EXEMPT FROM PARTICIPATION IN
- 4 WORK FIRST UNDER SECTION 57F(3), IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE FOOD
- 5 STAMPS UNDER THIS ACT FOR MORE THAN 3 MONTHS IN ANY 36-MONTH
- 6 PERIOD UNLESS THAT PERSON MEETS 1 OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:
- 7 (A) PERFORMS AT LEAST 25 HOURS OF COMMUNITY SERVICE WORK
- 8 ACTIVITIES DURING EACH CONSECUTIVE 30-DAY PERIOD.
- 9 (B) WORKS AT LEAST 80 HOURS OR MORE DURING EACH CONSECUTIVE 10 30-DAY PERIOD.
