THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. (1) A recognized postsecondary school in this state
- 2 is eligible to participate in the MEOG program under this act if
- 3 the postsecondary school is a degree-granting public institution
- 4 approved by the state board of education AND IS IN COMPLIANCE
- 5 WITH THE TAXPAYER-FUNDED ABORTION PROHIBITION ACT.
- 6 (2) A grant shall not be made under this act to a student
- 7 who is enrolled in a program of study leading to a degree in the-
