THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

SEC. 33. A TPA SHALL NOT ENTER INTO A SERVICE CONTRACT TO
 ADMINISTER A PLAN THAT REQUIRES A COVERED INDIVIDUAL TO DESIGNATE
 A PARTICIPATING PRIMARY CARE PROVIDER AND PROVIDES FOR ANNUAL
 WELL-WOMAN EXAMINATIONS AND ROUTINE OBSTETRICAL AND GYNECOLOGIC
 SERVICES UNLESS THE PLAN:

6 (A) PERMITS A FEMALE COVERED INDIVIDUAL TO ACCESS AN
7 OBSTETRICIAN-GYNECOLOGIST FOR ANNUAL WELL-WOMAN EXAMINATIONS AND
8 ROUTINE OBSTETRICAL AND GYNECOLOGIC SERVICES.

9 (B) DOES NOT REQUIRE PRIOR AUTHORIZATION OR REFERRAL FOR
10 ACCESS TO AN OBSTETRICIAN-GYNECOLOGIST WHO PARTICIPATES WITH THE
11 PLAN. THIS SUBDIVISION DOES NOT PROHIBIT A PLAN FROM REQUIRING
