## SENATE BILL NO. 1105

May 5, 1998, Introduced by Senator SHUGARS and referred to the Committee on Health Policy and Senior Citizens.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 7218 (MCL 333.7218) and by adding section 7401a.

- 1 SEC. 7401A. (1) A PERSON WHO, WITHOUT AN INDIVIDUAL'S
- 2 CONSENT, DELIVERS A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE OR CAUSES A CONTROLLED
- 3 SUBSTANCE TO BE DELIVERED TO THAT INDIVIDUAL TO COMMIT OR ATTEMPT
- 4 TO COMMIT A VIOLATION OF SECTION 520B, 520C, 520D, 520E, OR 520G
- 5 OF THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.520B, 750.520C,
- 6 750.520D, 750.520E, AND 750.520G, AGAINST THAT INDIVIDUAL IS
- 7 GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN
- 8 20 YEARS.
- (2) A CONVICTION OR SENTENCE UNDER THIS SECTION DOES NOT
- 10 PROHIBIT A CONVICTION OR SENTENCE FOR ANY OTHER CRIME ARISING OUT
- 11 OF THE SAME TRANSACTION.
- 12 (3) THIS SECTION APPLIES REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE PERSON IS
- 13 CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OR ATTEMPTED VIOLATION OF SECTION 520B,
- 14 520C, 520D, 520E, OR 520G OF THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE, 1931 PA
- 15 328, MCL 750.520B, 750.520C, 750.520D, 750.520E, AND 750.520G.
