- 3 INTENDED TO BE USED TO FALSIFY OR DISTORT THE RESULTS OF A DRUG
- 4 TEST REQUIRED OR AUTHORIZED BY LAW.
- 5 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 6 (A) "CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN
- 7 SECTION 7104 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL
- 8 333.7104.
- 9 (B) "DELIVER" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 7105 OF
- 10 THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.7105.

- 1 (C) "DRUG TEST" MEANS THE EXAMINATION OF A BODILY FLUID OR
- 2 SPECIMEN TO DETERMINE THE PRESENCE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE OR A
- 3 METABOLITE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE.
- 4 (3) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDE-
- 5 MEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR A
- 6 FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.
