ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 4162

AN ACT to designate an official mammal of this state.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Sec. 1. The white-tailed deer (*Odocoileus virginianus*) is designated as the official game mammal of this state.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
