 LIGHTS AS PERMITTED BY SECTION 698, THE DRIVER OF AN APPROACHING
 VEHICLE SHALL EXHIBIT DUE CARE AND CAUTION, AS REQUIRED UNDER THE
 FOLLOWING:

7 (A) ON ANY PUBLIC ROADWAY WITH AT LEAST 2 ADJACENT LANES
8 PROCEEDING IN THE SAME DIRECTION OF THE STATIONARY AUTHORIZED
