A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," (MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1305.

- 1 SEC. 1305. (1) NOT LATER THAN THE BEGINNING OF THE
- 2 2000-2001 SCHOOL YEAR, THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR LOCAL
- 3 ACT SCHOOL DISTRICT OR THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL
- 4 ACADEMY SHALL ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT A POLICY ON FIREARM SAFETY AND
- $\bf 5$ AWARENESS [AND CONFLICT RESOLUTION INSTRUCTION] FOR ITS PUPILS IN GRADES K TO 6. THE BOARD OR BOARD OF
- 6 DIRECTORS SHALL PROVIDE A COPY OF THE POLICY TO THE DEPARTMENT
- 7 UPON REQUEST BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 8 (2) THE FIREARM SAFETY AND AWARENESS [AND CONFLICT RESOLUTION INSTRUCTION] POLICY REQUIRED UNDER
- 9 SUBSECTION (1) MAY INCLUDE, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, ANY FIREARM
- 10 SAFETY AND AWARENESS PROGRAM OR INFORMATION ESTABLISHED BY THE
- 11 DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE, FIREARM SAFETY AND AWARENESS

- 18 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, SHALL DEVELOP AND MAKE AVAILABLE TO
- 19 SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMIES A MODEL POLICY ON
- 20 FIREARM SAFETY AND AWARENESS THAT MAY BE ADOPTED FOR THE PURPOSES
- 21 OF THIS SECTION.
- 22 (5) A BOARD OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS SHALL ENSURE THAT FIREARMS
- 23 ARE NOT BROUGHT INTO A SCHOOL BUILDING FOR THE PROGRAMS DESCRIBED
- 24 IN THIS SECTION EXCEPT BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER AUTHORIZED TO
- 25 CARRY A FIREARM. HOWEVER, A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER SHALL NOT
- 26 USE OR SHOW A FIREARM AS PART OF THE PROGRAMS DESCRIBED IN THIS
- 27 SECTION.
