THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

An act to provide for the registration, titling, sale,

transfer, and regulation of certain vehicles operated upon the

public highways of this state or any other place open to the gen
eral public or generally accessible to motor vehicles and dis
tressed vehicles; to provide for the licensing of dealers; to

provide for the examination, licensing, and control of operators

and chauffeurs; to provide for the giving of proof of financial

responsibility and security by owners and operators of vehicles;

to provide for the imposition, levy, and collection of specific
