## SENATE BILL 725

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 20965 (MCL 333.20965), as amended by 1997 PA 78.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 20965. (1) Unless an act or omission is the result of
- 2 gross negligence or willful misconduct, the acts or omissions of
- 3 a medical first responder, emergency medical technician, emer-
- 4 gency medical technician specialist, paramedic, or medical direc-
- 5 tor of a medical control authority or his or her designee while
- 6 providing services to a patient outside a hospital, or in a hos-
- 7 pital before transferring patient care to hospital personnel,
- 8 that are consistent with the individual's licensure or additional
- 9 training required by the local medical control authority,
- 10 INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, SERVICES DESCRIBED IN

- 1 SUBSECTION (2), do not impose liability in the treatment of a
- 2 patient on those individuals or any of the following persons:
- (a) The authorizing physician or physician's designee. 3
- (b) The medical director and individuals serving on the 4

- (c) The person providing communications services or lawfully 6
- 7 operating or utilizing supportive electronic communications
