- 6 (2) THE SPECIALTY SERVICES PANEL SHALL CONSIST OF THE FOL-

- 8 (A) THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH OR

- [(8)] THE SPECIALTY SERVICES PANEL SHALL SOLICIT AND CONSIDER

- 6 WORKERS IN THE AREAS OF MENTAL HEALTH [, DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, ] OR SUBSTANCE ABUSE
- 7 SERVICES.
