TAX THAT PART OF THE PURCHASE PRICE OF A NEW AUTOMOBILE PART
ATTRIBUTABLE TO THE TRADE-IN VALUE OF A USED AUTOMOBILE PART USED
AS PART PAYMENT FOR THE NEW AUTOMOBILE PART.
