

HOUSE BILL No. 4901

September 28, 1999, Introduced by Rep. Law and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1279g.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1279G. (1) IF A PUPIL TAKING A MEAP TEST HAS BEEN
- 2 ABSENT FROM SCHOOL FOR 30 OR MORE SCHOOL DAYS DURING THE SCHOOL
- 3 YEAR IN WHICH THE TEST IS TAKEN, THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR PUBLIC
- 4 SCHOOL ACADEMY IN WHICH THE PUPIL IS ENROLLED MAY DESIGNATE ON
- 5 THAT PORTION OF THE TEST THAT IS RETURNED TO THE DEPARTMENT THAT
- 6 THE PUPIL IS A HIGH ABSENTEEISM PUPIL.
- 7 (2) IF A PUPIL IS DESIGNATED AS A HIGH ABSENTEEISM PUPIL AS
- 8 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1), ALL OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:
- 9 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT USE THE PUPIL'S MEAP TEST
- 10 RESULTS FOR DETERMINING THE ACCREDITATION STATUS OF THE PUPIL'S
- 11 SCHOOL UNDER SECTION 1280.

- 1 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT INCLUDE THE PUPIL'S MEAP TEST
- 2 RESULTS IN REPORTING THE AGGREGATE MEAP TEST RESULTS OF THAT
- 3 SCHOOL DISTRICT OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY FOR ANY PURPOSE.
- 4 (3) NOT LATER THAN MARCH 30, 2000, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 5 DEVELOP A UNIFORM PROCEDURE FOR SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND PUBLIC
- 6 SCHOOL ACADEMIES TO USE FOR DESIGNATING A PUPIL AS A HIGH ABSEN-
- 7 TEEISM PUPIL AS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) AND SHALL NOTIFY
- 8 SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMIES OF THIS PROCEDURE.
- 9 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "MEAP TEST" MEANS A TEST ADMIN-
- 10 ISTERED AS PART OF THE MICHIGAN EDUCATIONAL ASSESSMENT PROGRAM OR
- 11 ADMINISTERED UNDER SECTION 1279.
