A bill to provide for reciprocal access of electric service between electric utilities and alternative electric suppliers under certain conditions.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 2 (a) "Alternative electric supplier" means a person selling
- 3 electric generation service to retail consumers in this state but
- 4 not physically delivering electricity directly to those retail
- 5 consumers.
- 6 (b) "Commission" means the Michigan public service commis-
- 7 sion in the department of consumer and industry services.
- 8 (c) "Delivery service" means the transmission and distribu-
- 9 tion services subject to the jurisdiction of the commission that
- 10 are provided by an electric utility.

- 1 (d) "Electric utility" means a person physically delivering
- 2 electricity directly to retail consumers in the United States.
- 3 Sec. 2. (1) The commission shall not require an electric

- 6 also an electric utility or an affiliate of an electric utility
