THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 237B. (1) A PERSON WHO SELLS A FIREARM, AMMUNITION, OR
- 2 DANGEROUS WEAPON TO A VISIBLY INTOXICATED INDIVIDUAL IS GUILTY OF
- 3 A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 90
- 4 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.
- 5 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 6 (A) "DANGEROUS WEAPON" MEANS A KNIFE WITH A BLADE LENGTH OF
- 7 MORE THAN 3 INCHES, STABBING INSTRUMENT, BRASS KNUCKLES, BLACK-
- 8 JACK, CLUB, OR OTHER OBJECT SPECIFICALLY DESIGNED OR CUSTOMARILY
- 9 CARRIED OR POSSESSED FOR USE AS A WEAPON.
- 10 (B) "VISIBLY INTOXICATED" MEANS THAT THE INDIVIDUAL'S SENSES
- 11 ARE OBSERVABLY DESTROYED, IMPAIRED, DISTURBED, OR DISTRACTED BY

- 1 THE CONSUMPTION OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR OR THAT THE INDIVIDUAL'S
