## **SENATE BILL No. 1418**

October 5, 2000, Introduced by Senators HAMMERSTROM, JOHNSON, GOUGEON and GOSCHKA and referred to the Committee on Families, Mental Health and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled "The social welfare act,"

(MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 109g.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 109G. (1) THE GOVERNOR SHALL CREATE A SPECIALTY SERV-
- 2 ICES PANEL WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH TO REVIEW
- 3 APPLICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION SUBMITTED BY COMMUNITY MENTAL
- 4 HEALTH SERVICES PROGRAMS OR OTHER MANAGING ENTITIES. THE PANEL
- 5 SHALL SERVE IN AN ADVISORY CAPACITY TO THE DIRECTOR OF THE
- 6 DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH REGARDING PERFORMANCE AND QUALITY
- 7 RELATING TO MEDICAID SPECIALTY SERVICES AND SUPPORTS.
- 8 (2) THE SPECIALTY SERVICES PANEL SHALL CONSIST OF THE FOL-
- 9 LOWING MEMBERS, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR:
- 10 (A) THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH OR
- 11 HIS OR HER REPRESENTATIVE.

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- 1 (B) TWO MEMBERS WHO REPRESENT THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY
- 2 HEALTH, EXCLUDING A PERSON APPOINTED UNDER SUBDIVISION (A).
- 3 (C) THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET
- 4 OR HIS OR HER REPRESENTATIVE.
- 5 (D) FOUR MEMBERS WHO REPRESENT PRIMARY CONSUMERS OR FAMILY
- 6 MEMBERS. AT LEAST 1 MEMBER APPOINTED UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION
- 7 SHALL REPRESENT SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES.
- 8 (E) FOUR MEMBERS WHO REPRESENT OTHER STAKEHOLDERS, INCLUD-
- 9 ING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, 1 REPRESENTATIVE EACH FROM THE STATEWIDE
- 10 ADVOCACY ORGANIZATIONS REPRESENTING ADULTS WITH SERIOUS MENTAL
- 11 ILLNESS, CHILDREN WITH SERIOUS EMOTIONAL DISTURBANCE, AND INDI-
- 12 VIDUALS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES. AT LEAST 1 MEMBER
- 13 APPOINTED UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE A COUNTY COMMISSIONER.
- 14 (3) MEMBERS OF THE SPECIALTY SERVICES PANEL SHALL SERVE FOR
- 15 TERMS OF 4 YEARS OR UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED, WHICHEVER IS
- 16 LATER, EXCEPT THAT OF THE MEMBERS FIRST APPOINTED 4 SHALL SERVE
- 17 FOR 1 YEAR, 4 SHALL SERVE FOR 2 YEARS, AND 4 SHALL SERVE FOR 3
- 18 YEARS.
- 19 (4) IF A VACANCY OCCURS ON THE SPECIALTY SERVICES PANEL, THE
- 20 GOVERNOR SHALL MAKE AN APPOINTMENT FOR THE UNEXPIRED TERM IN THE
- 21 SAME MANNER AS THE ORIGINAL APPOINTMENT.
- 22 (5) A MEMBER OF THE SPECIALTY SERVICES PANEL SHALL MAKE
- 23 KNOWN ANY MATTER IN WHICH THAT MEMBER HAS A POTENTIAL CONFLICT OF
- 24 INTEREST.
- 25 (6) THE SPECIALTY SERVICES PANEL SHALL REMAIN IN EXISTENCE
- 26 TO SERVE IN AN ADVISORY CAPACITY TO THE DIRECTOR OF THE
- 27 DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH. THE PANEL SHALL MEET NO LESS

- 1 THAN 2 TIMES A YEAR. THE PANEL SHALL HAVE ACCESS TO ALL
- 2 AGGREGATE QUALITY MANAGEMENT INFORMATION GATHERED BY THE DEPART-
- 3 MENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH RELATING TO THE MANAGING ENTITIES.

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
